

Inaugural Ceremony

The day-one of UDYAM'2019 began with welcoming the new entrants. The senior students welcomed the freshers with tilak. All the students got the welcome kit during their registration for the event. The inaugural ceremony began with lamplighting. Vice Chancellor Dr. S. S. Razi, Director Mr. Amit Kumar Shrivastava, Chief Guest of session Mr. Santosh Sharma, Dean Dr. Angad Tiwary, Program Coordinator Dr. Charu Wadhwa lighted all the faculty members and all the students of MBA marked their presence.

Motivational Talk by the Chief Guest Mr. Santosh Sharma

Mr. Santosh Sharma is known as the father of "Dissolve the box" strategy, TED Talk speaker, Management Legend, Delhi University commerce graduate, a qualified Cost and Management Accountant and a Product of the American Management Association. He is also the author of the book "Next What's In", mentor to many corporate leaders and a social entrepreneur working for an inclusive and sustainable growth. He has also designed a model as a solution to the present issues like corruption, crime and rape which is already presented to the policy makers and the UN for its implementation. His second book is in the making and is titled "Dissolve the box". It is for those who want to live, grow, lead, create and act.

He had made his deliberations to motivate new student to Dream Big and pursue the dream, work hard for it and wait till success. His mantra as stated was to channelize and dedicate oneself to Dream makes success. He shared his personal experiences from student life – a very shy boy hesitant to respond to teacher and how one day his teacher gave him life lesson – "If you are not doing something wrong, do not hide yourself". He walked out of the corporate world dumping his illustrious corporate career with 5 industry leaders and is now doing what he feels is most important for humankind. And that is providing "internal freedom to individuals and organizations to take on external challenges" which is actually so fundamental for a better life and a better world. He shared with students that he believes physical and economic freedom is not enough and it's now time to go deeper for inner freedom.

Faculty Introduction, Senior's Speak and Scheme of Study

A brief introduction of all the faculty members of the MBA department was presented followed by an interaction of senior students of MBA. Second-year students shared their experiences at ARKA Jain University and motivated the freshers for taking part in all co-curricular activities. The freshers also introduced themselves and this way the interaction was the first step towards breaking the ice. The scheme of study for MBA Programme was also shared with the students.

Business Quiz
