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# INTRODUCTION

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
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# **►** Inauguration Ceremony:

# **Entertainment Quiz:**



Session was started by clarifying the distinction between start-ups and businesses. He explained the ways how an entrepreneur of a start-up can acquire fund from the market in its initial days. He talked about the importance of networking. Various pros and cons are explained very well. He talked about the skills which an entrepreneur must have to grow his/her business from scratch to top.

**Ms. Jayanti Pradhan**- She is the only Agri entrepreneur from Eastern India. She is the Managing Director of Gopal biotech Agro farm. She did her Post Graduation from XLRI, Jamshedpur. She is been working on different Agri-livelihood program specially on mushroom farming using waste such as Paddy straw since 2005. She has been recognised as an Agri- entrepreneur and her farm was selected as a Model Farm by the Ministry of Agriculture, Govt. of India and by the Food and Agriculture

Organisation (FAO) on World Food Day in 2009.

Jayanti Pradhan was the speaker for the second half of the session. Her topic of discussion is *Agripreneurship*. She belongs to the family where agriculture is the main occupation for livelihood. Where people are leaving agriculture as their means of livelihood, she tried to indulge herself in best practices and better utilisation of the available land. She modified her land in a way which has not only increased crop production but also her farm was selected as Model Farm by the Ministry of Agriculture. She even taught us how one can make productive use of waste left. She talked about mushroom farming, most producing crop i.e. Paddy in Orissa, poultry farming and the emergence of organic farming nowadays. She also explained about number of people she is providing training inthe field of agriculture. Her session was very informative and she is been an inspiration for those who think agriculture has no scope. She also educates women in her community and enabling them to become financially independent and thus works for women empowerment. Her journey inspires each and every person present in the session.



### A session on Zumba: A fun way to health by Ms. Usha Gope

The session ended with Nahid mirza maam proposing vote of thanks to all our speakers.




#### Mentor- Mentee Session:
