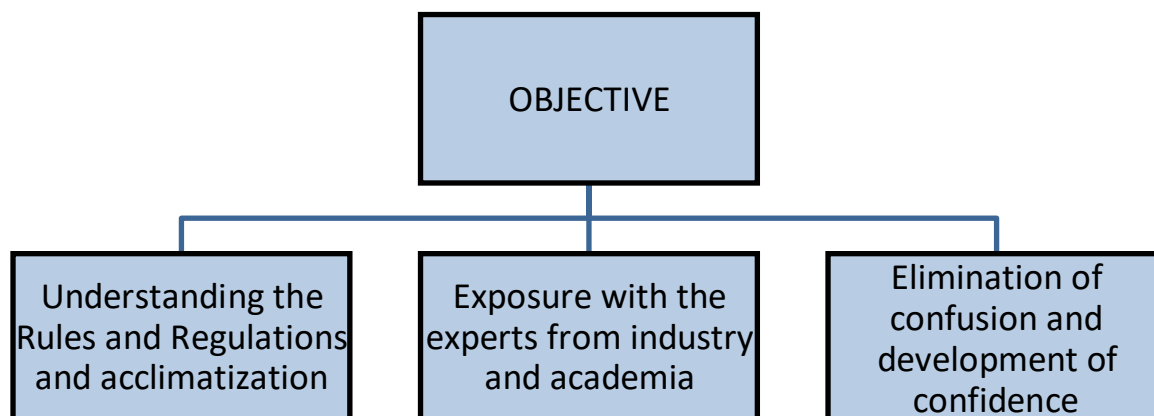

WELCOME

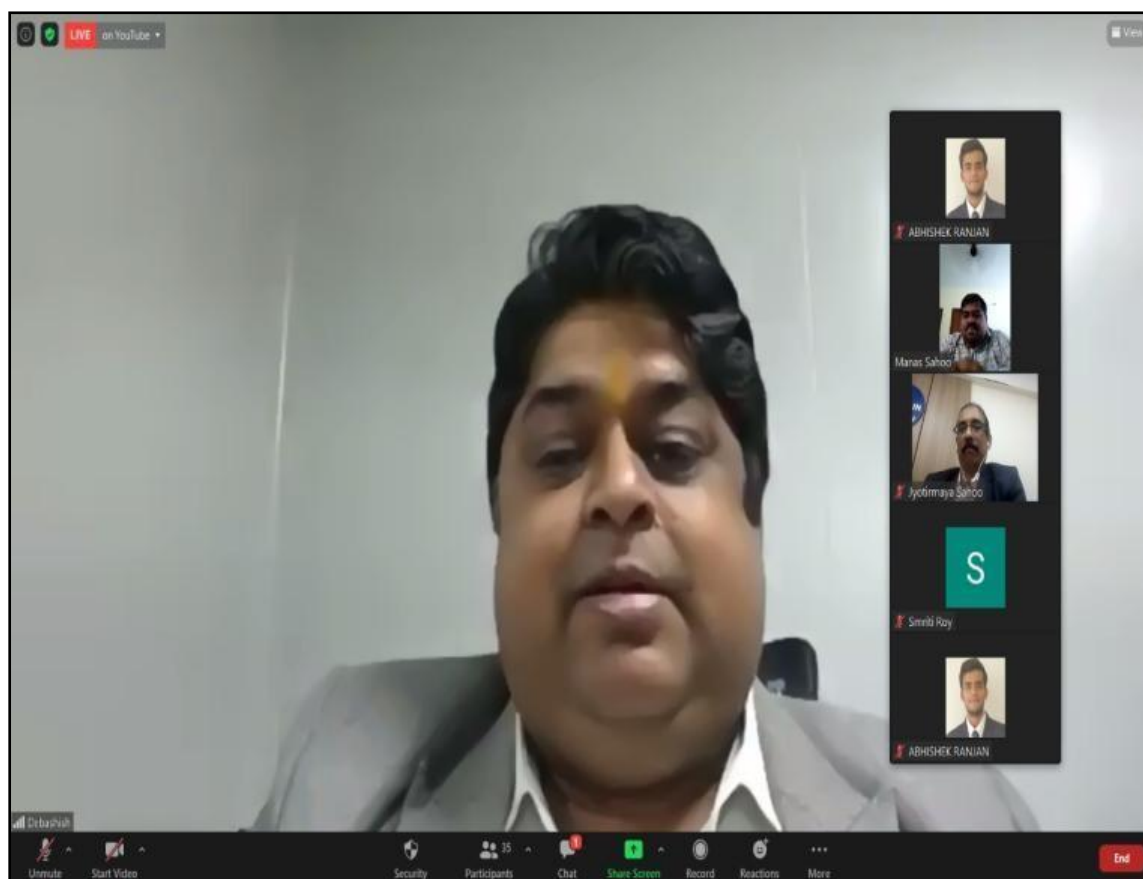

CONCLUSION

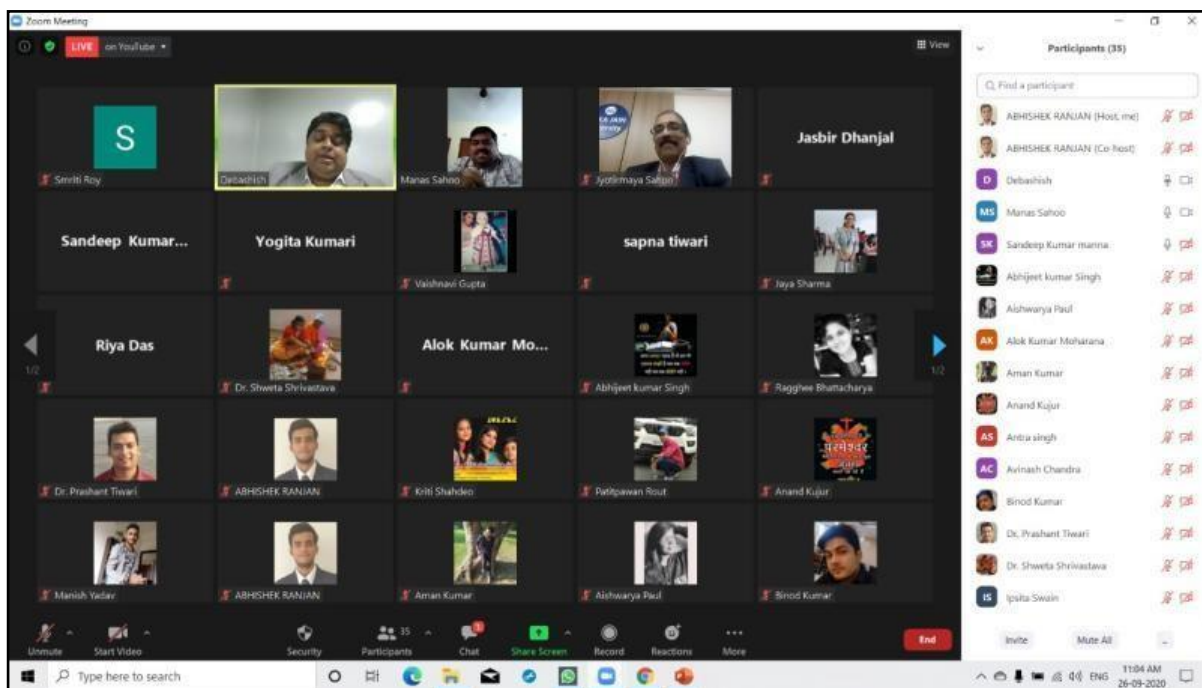


