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About Exit Student (Passing Out Batch) Feedback Survey 2020


Exit Student Survey was conducted with the batch passing out in the year 2020. Survey questionnaire was prepared considering three major aspects

- 1) Robustness of curriculum 2) University Infrastructure and Resources 3) Faculty and Teaching Assistance


Approximately 379 students out of 770 students participated in the online survey. Response received was then tabulated and was presented in graphical pictorial form for better understanding of each of the area. Overall findings of the reports are as below:



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Overall Findings of Exit Student Feedback on Curriculum and University Resources

Feedback on overall Curriculum

- More than 75% students either agreed or strongly agreed that course was good and challenging
- 73% Students either agreed or strongly agreed that course curriculum was rich and work oriented
- 60% believed that there was a good variety of electives to choose from

Feedback on University Resources

- More than 80% students believed that class room resources are either good or very good
- 75% Students have rated library resources as either good or very good
- More than 75% Students have rated computer resources as either good or very good
- 60% students have rated sports related resources are either good or very good
- Less than 55% have rated Canteen facility as good or very good
- Only 40% have rated career guidance and placement related services as good or very good
- 68% student said they have received good or very good assistance other than classes

Feedback on Faculty Resources

- 76% students have rated university as good or very good on extracurricular activities
- 77% students agreed or strongly agreed that faculties have up to date knowledge & skills
- 83% students believed that the faculty were perceptive and understood the individual needs of the students
- 86% students believed that faculty demonstrated enthusiasm for their subjects as well as for teaching
- 76% students believes that faculty took a keen interest in the professional development of the students
- 76% students believes that faculty were accessible outside of the classroom
- 74% students believes that faculty evaluated assignments regularly and gave feedback on students' performance at regular intervals

76% students of passing out batch 2020 have rated their experience in the university as Good or very good



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Major Improvement Areas identified as Outcome of Exit Student Feedback

Committee constituted for analysis of Exit Student Feedback have identified and recommended following key improvement areas:

1

It was recommended by committee to further strengthen Career Guidance and Placement Cell, so that maximum placement opportunities could be provided to students. It was recommended to conduct the career guidance seminar and workshop especially for final year students at regular interval by inviting various industry resource persons. This should be jointly done by individual departments and career development and placement cell

It was further recommended by committee to increase the option of various electives in all the courses for which syllabus is designed by Board of Studies of the University. Considering the limitation of changing the syllabus on immediate basis, it was recommended that awareness session about MOOC portal like SWAYAM / COURSEARA / LINKDIN Learnings / UDEMY etc. must be organized, so that students can make aware about various option of free and paid learning resources on various range of courses, which is available online. It is also recommended to various BOS to facilitate the Credit Transfer scheme up to 25% of total credit using MOOC portal like SWAYAM, so that students can do courses which are not available in the university syllabus.

It was recommended to improve the present infrastructure of Canteen and Sports facilities. It was suggested to make sufficient budgetary allocation to construct a new centralized canteen with at least 200 seating capacity, with separate seating area for university staff. Canteen mess may be outsourced to a reputed vendor. It is further recommended to plan a separate space for practice of sports like Football, Volleyball and indoor games like Table Tennis, Chess, Carom etc.

Committee has recommended IQAC cell to present action taken report on above recommendation in the quarterly IQAC cell meeting

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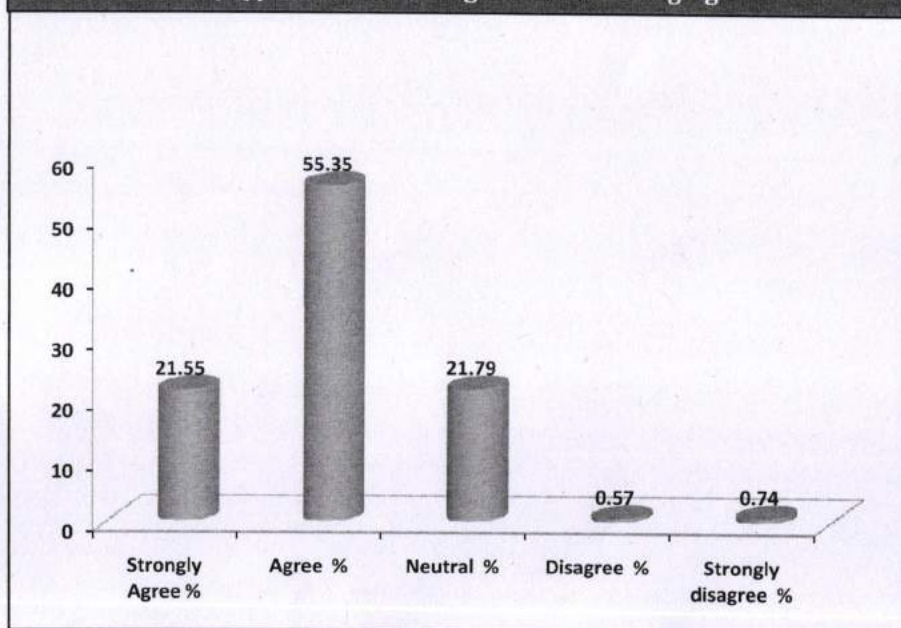
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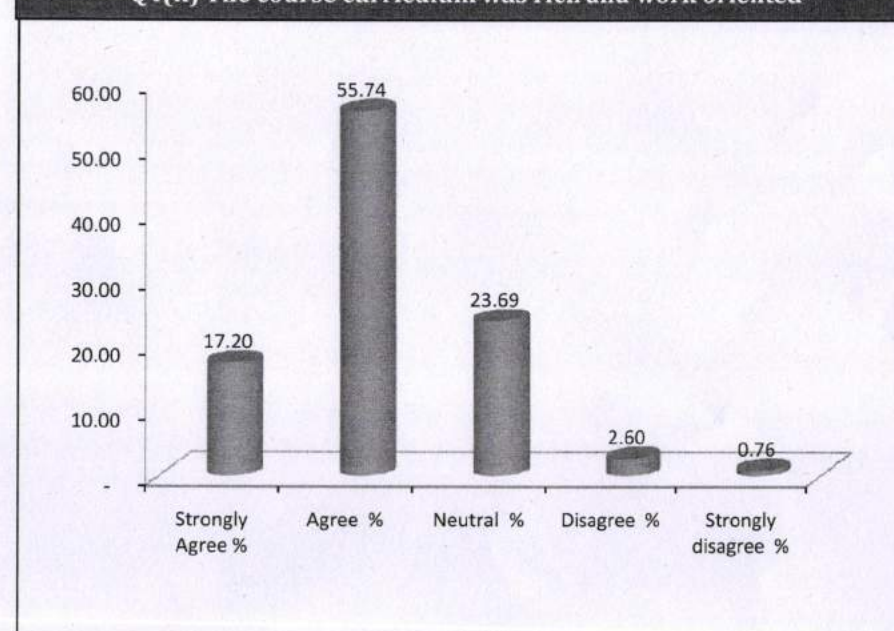

Q4(ii) The course curriculum was rich and work oriented

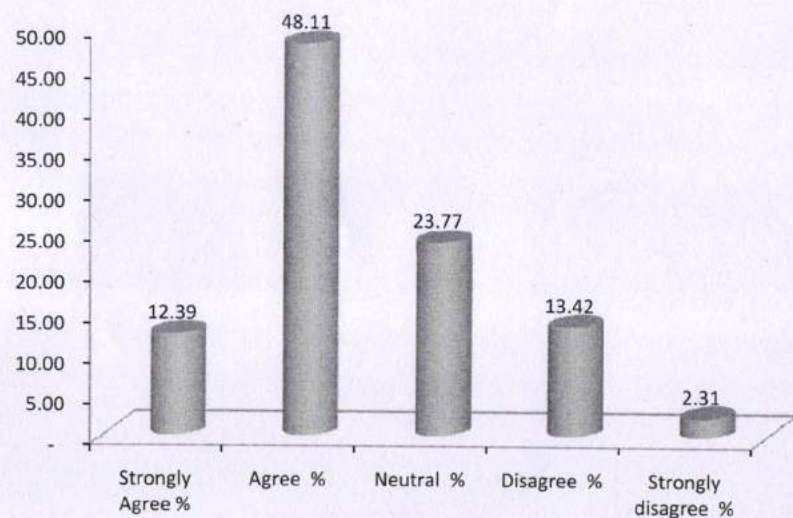



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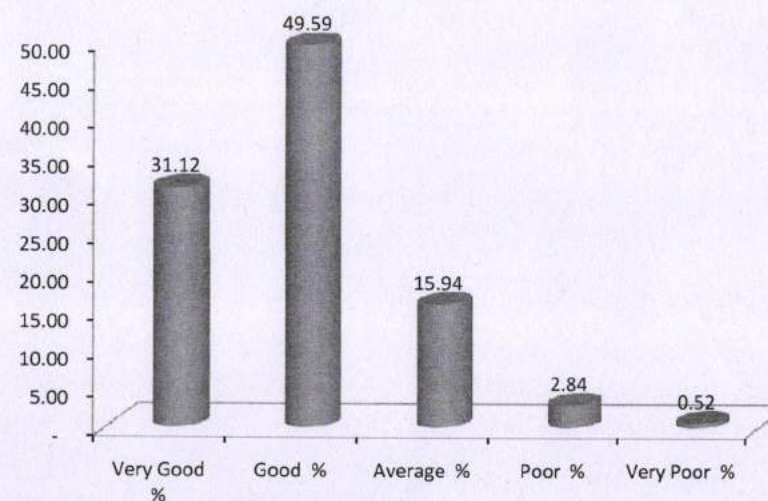

Q4(iii) There was a good variety of electives to choose from



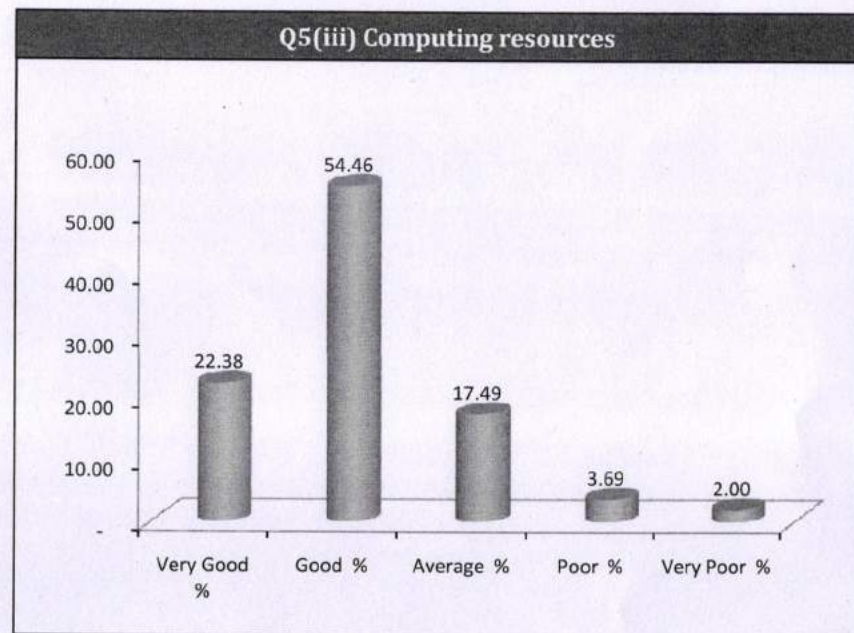
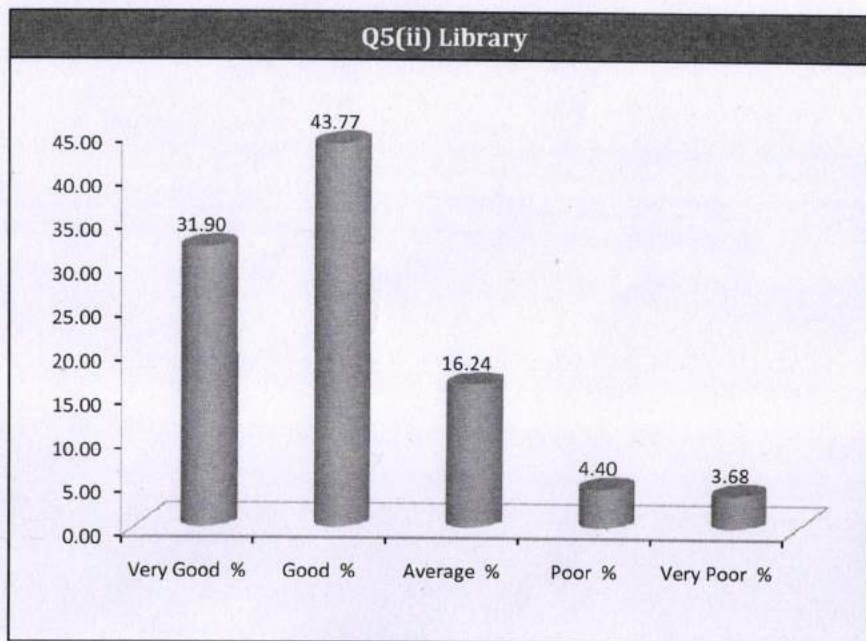
Q5(i) Classroom resources

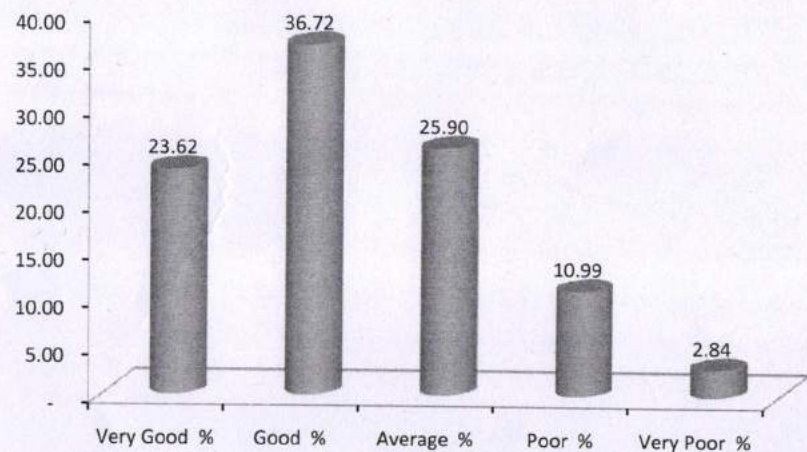
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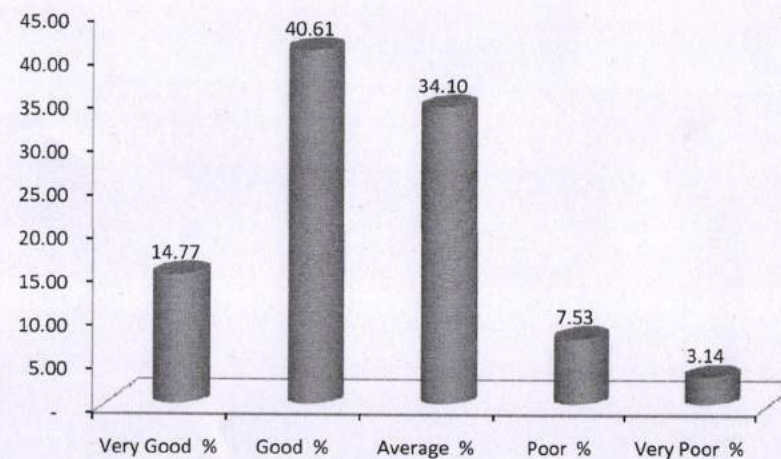

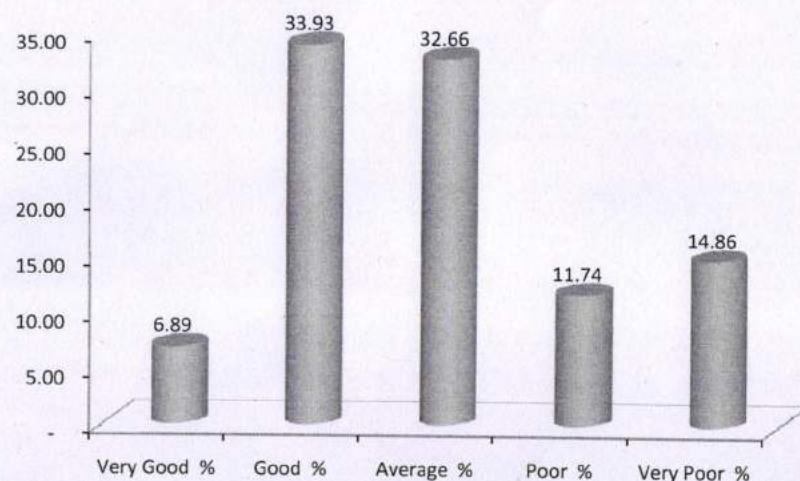

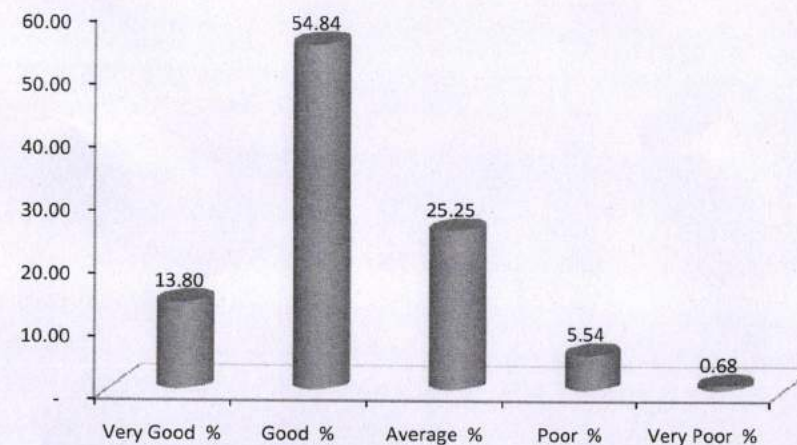

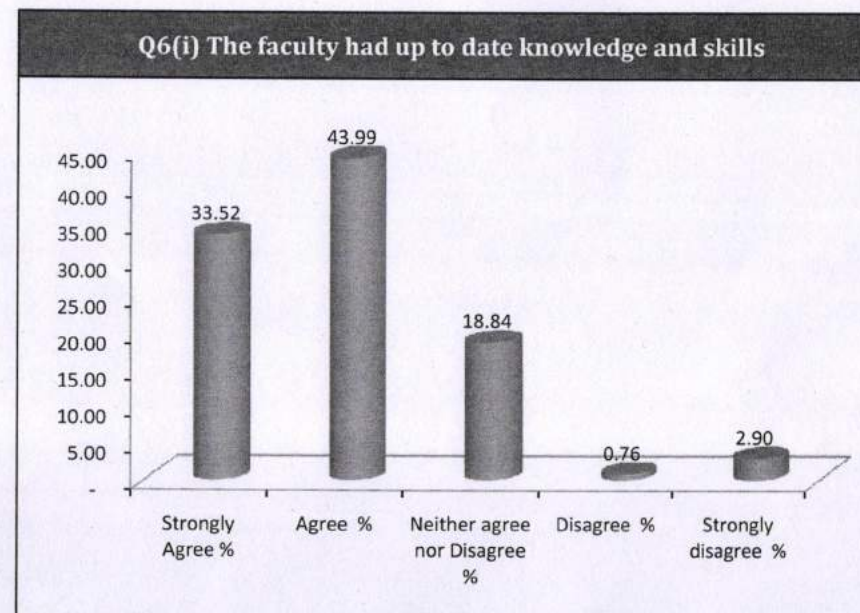
