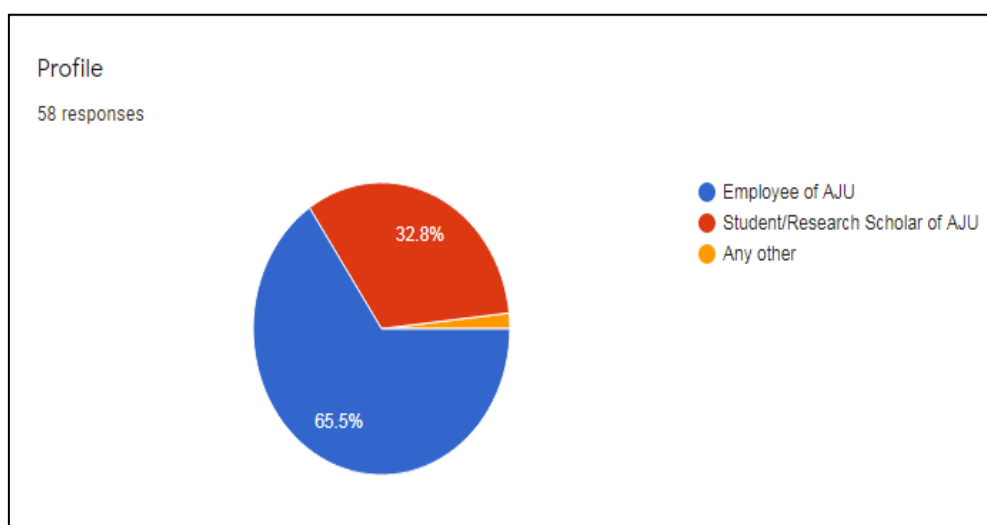

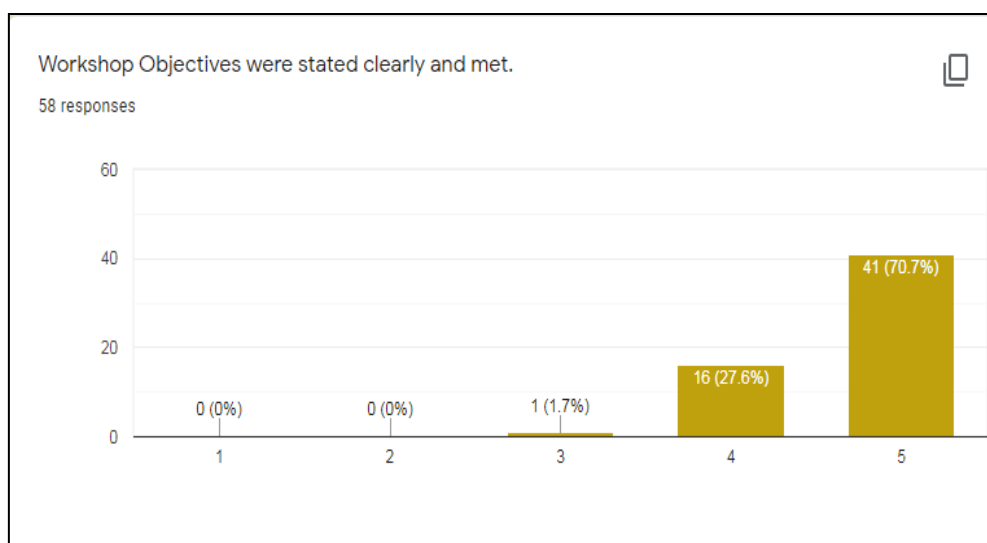

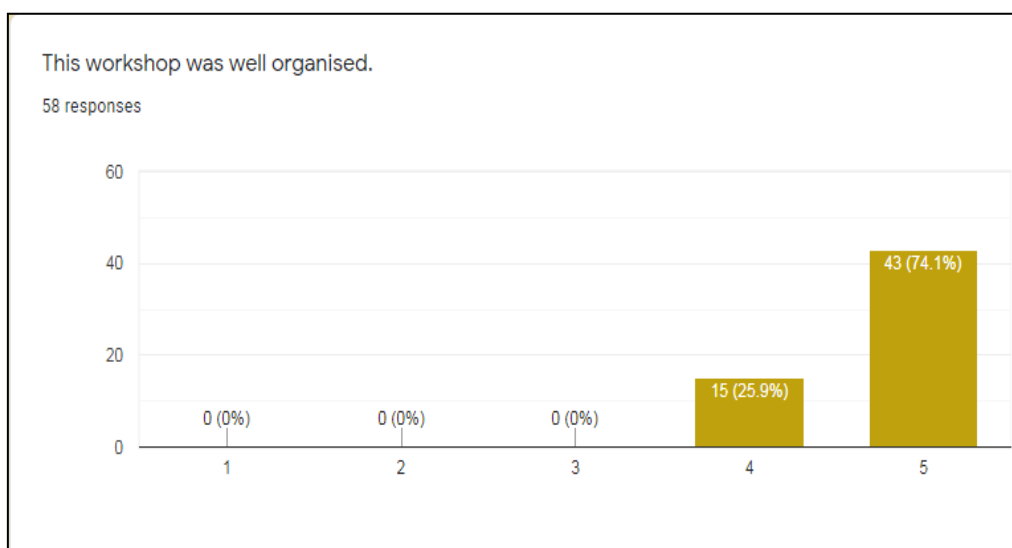
**Chart 1: Profile of the respondents**



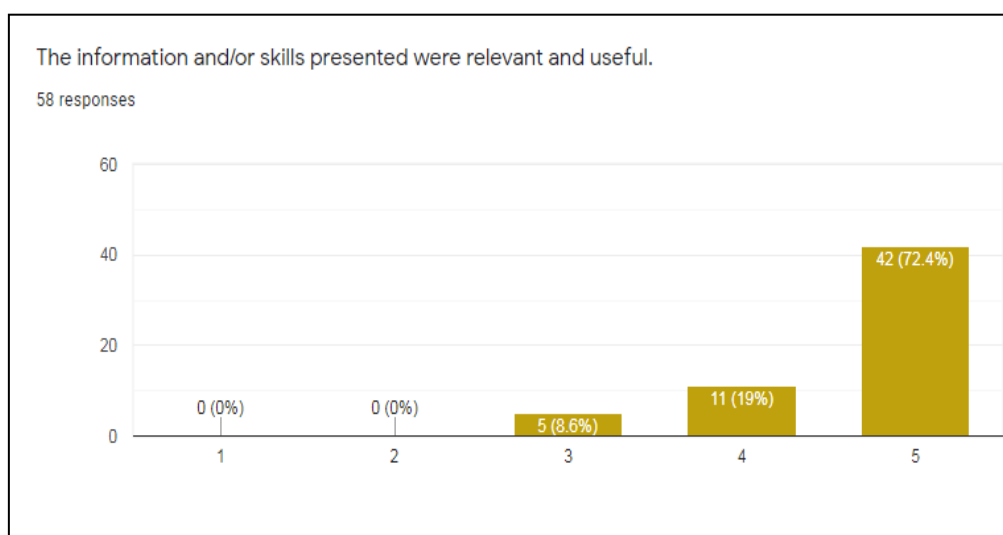
**Chart 2: Responses on the statement ‘Workshop Objectives were stated clearly and met’**



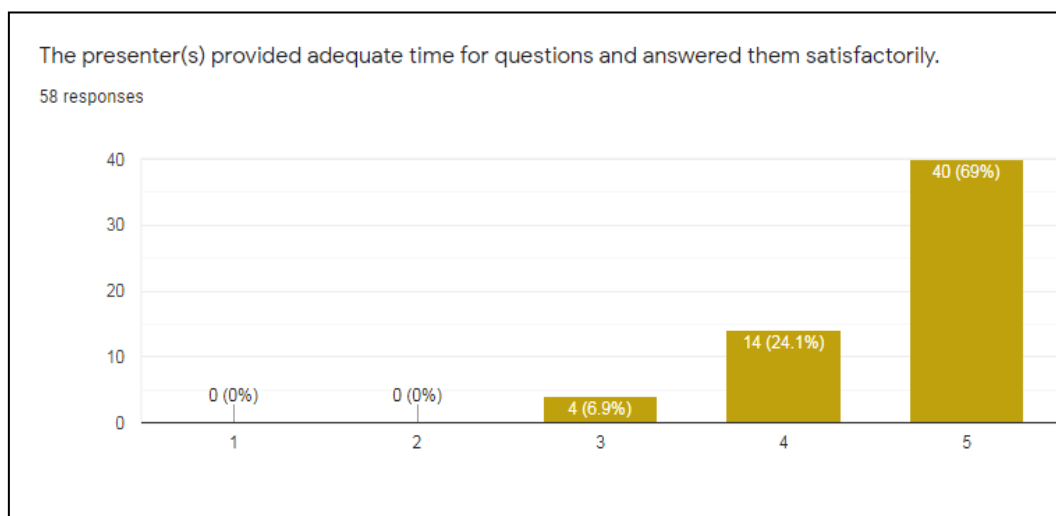
**Chart 3: Responses on the statement ‘This workshop was well organised’**



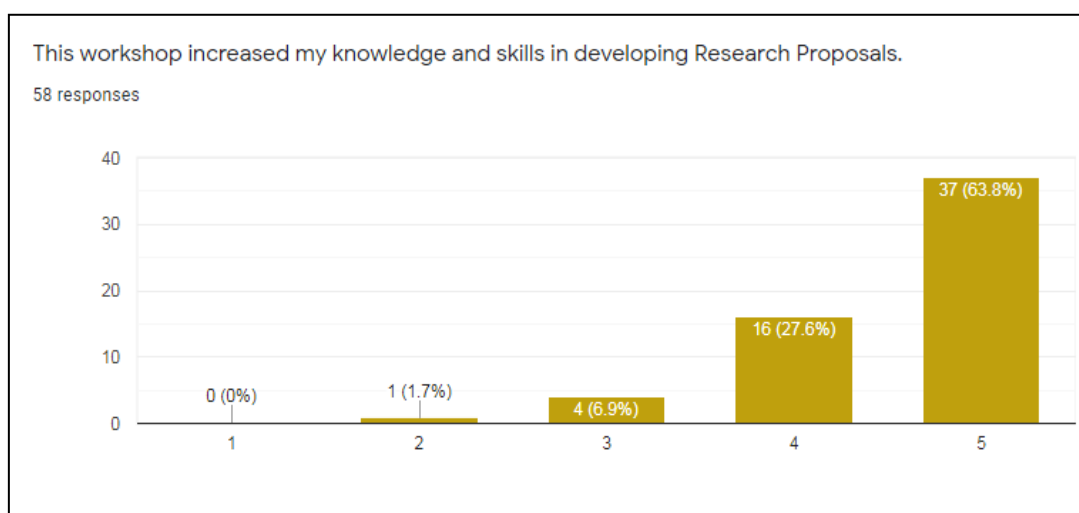
**Chart 4: Responses on the statement ‘The information and/or skills presented were relevant and useful.’**



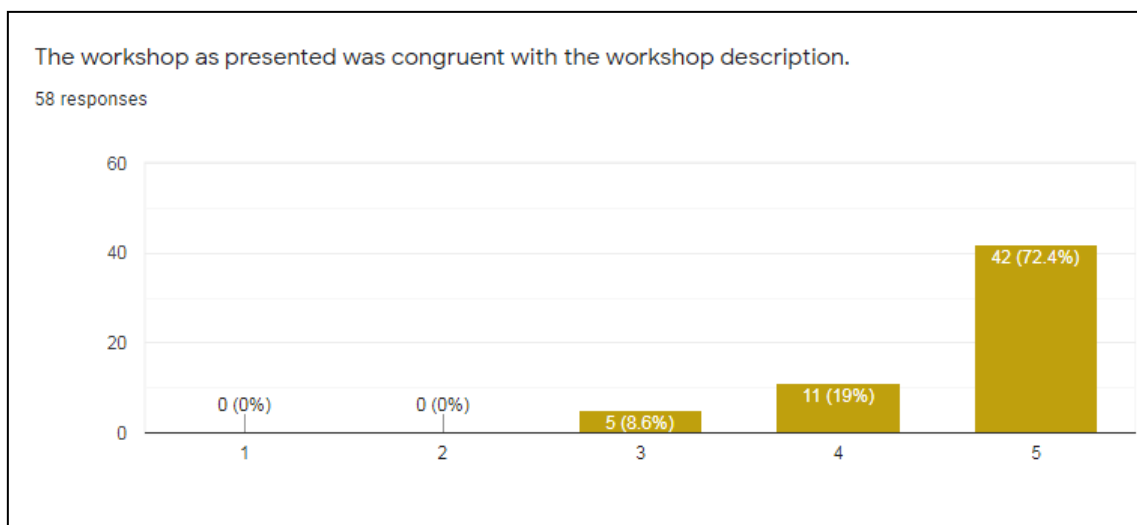
**Chart 5: Responses on the statement ‘The presenter(s) provided adequate time for questions and answered them satisfactorily.’**



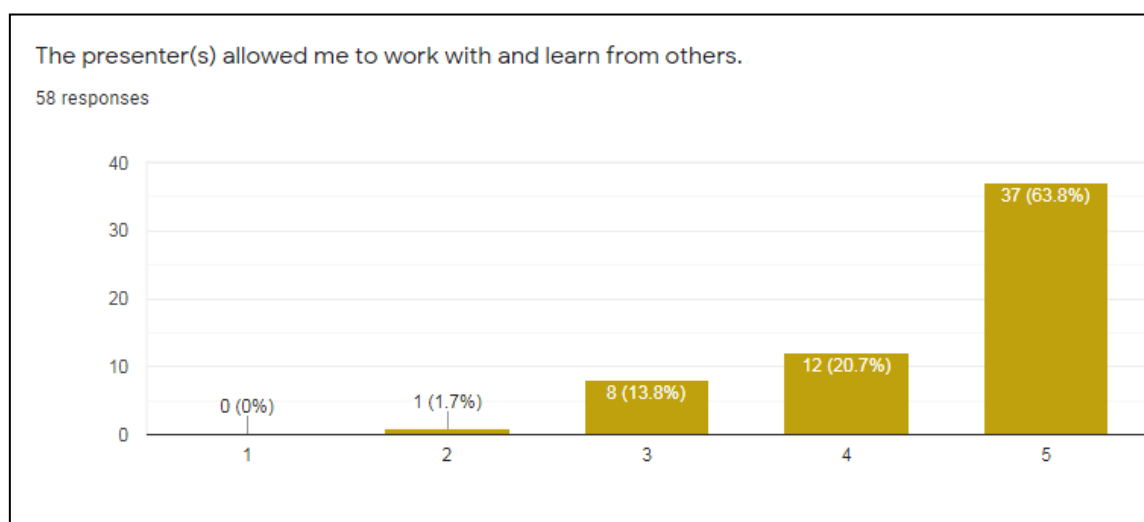
**Chart 6: Responses on the statement ‘This workshop increased my knowledge and skills in developing Research Proposal.’**
