SAMARTHYA IT'S Our INDIA Too

Research has found that attempted suicide rates and suicidal ideation among lesbian, gay, bisexual, transgender (LGBT) youth is significantly higher than among the general population.

The passage of laws that discriminate against LGBT people have been shown to have significant negative impacts on the physical and mental health and well-being of LGBT youth. Bullying of LGBT youth has been shown to be a major contributing factor in many suicides, even if not all of the attacks have been specifically regarding sexuality or gender.

Reports have also shown that unemployment and homelessness also lead to a majority of community members attempting suicide.

Research by the Family Acceptance Project has demonstrated that "parental acceptance, and even neutrality, with regard to a child's sexual orientation" can bring down the attempted suicide rate.
