- 24. Selling is nothing but getting attention.


25. A swimmer can swim anywhere, where there is water. One should act accordingly. Acquiring skills is important.

26. The person who is interviewing a fresher knows very well that he/she doesn't know much. Hence one mustn't panic in their first job interview.


- 27. There are tricks to crack interview which students should keep in mind.
