PLANNING PHASE





ORIENTATION PROGRAMME

In Association with Industry Institute Interaction Cell (IIIC) & MOU Partners of AJU

The induction and orientation program "AARAMBH 21" has been celebrated by the School of Pharmacy, ARKA JAIN University in association with Industry Institute Interaction Cell (IIIC) & MOU partners of AJU for both B. Pharm and D. Pharm students who have taken admission in academic session 2021. Keeping the COVID 19 guideline in view, the event was conducted virtually from 15th September to 19th September 2021.

EVENT DETAILS:

15th September 2021

The inauguration of the event was done by honorable Vice chancellor Professor Dr. S. S. Razi, Registrar Mr. Jasbir Singh Dhanjal, Director Mr. Mr.Amit Kumar Shrivastav, Dean of Student Welfare Dr. Angad Tiwari, Chief Finance & Account Officer Mrs. Richa Garg. Dr. Jyotirmaya Sahoo.

In the Introductory session, Vice Chancellor Professor (Dr.) S. S. Razi, gave a brief address and congratulated the students who took admission in School of Pharmacy, ARKA JAIN University. He urged the students to constructively utilize the resources available in the University. He assured that teaching and non-teaching staff of the University will extend complete co-operation and support necessary for the students. He pointed to the diversity from several angles yet the oneness and unity in the University. Dr. Jyotirmaya Sahoo, Dean, School of Pharmacy addressed the students and suggested to be sincere and punctual in life. He talked about how vulnerable the stage of student life may be, how easily a student can be attracted into several weaknesses, but how with a strength of will, feeling of self-responsibility, choice of good friends and positive attitude, and clarity in goal set for oneself, one can overcome them and emerge stronger.

Introduction of Teaching & Non-teaching staff of School of Pharmacy were done virtually. As every child needs and deserves, dedicated, outstanding teachers, who know their subject matter, are effectively trained, and know how to teach to high standards and to make learning come alive for students.

1st Day AARAMBH 21

The Chief Guest of 1st Day AARAMBH 21 was Mr. T. Sathish, Vice President -Regulatory & Corporate Support, Tablets (India) Limited, Chennai. He discussed about career in the pharmaceutical sector depends on an overall knowledge of this sector and on a smart strategy for job application. He briefly explained about pharmaceutical field offers a variety of job and career opportunities to young talented graduates with a sound background in life sciences, pharmaceutical sciences, chemistry and various other academic disciplines. Drug discovery research is highly dependent on biotechnologists, molecular biologists, biochemists, bioinformaticians, biostatistician and biomedical scientists; medicinal chemists, computer-assisted drug designers, protein and analytical chemists; pharmacologists, toxicologists, bio pharmacy and pharmaceutical technology experts; bio-engineers, medical and scientific writers, intellectual property specialists and patent lawyers. The pharmaceutical industry has diverse roles to offer to trained professionals in key areas of clinical research trials, regulatory affairs, drug development and safety, business development and medical affairs.

The second session was chaired by Dr. Manoj Pathak, Assistant Professor of English at Dept. of English, ARKA JAIN University, Jamshedpur (Jharkhand) and a multi-lingual poet, editor, reviewer and translator. He has his doctoral degree on the topic, "The Novels of Amitav Ghosh: Towards an Interpretation of Narrative Aesthetics". His research and academic interest lies in Indian Fiction, Aesthetics of Narratives, Post-colonialism, Indian Philosophy and Literature, Nation and Nationalism in India, Youth and Education and Cultural Studies. He has a teaching experience of nearly 14 years. Dr. Pathak has 10 books of self-composed poetry to his credit in 5 languages other than research papers and conference proceedings and hundreds of poems and articles in news dailies, magazines and mews letters. He delivered his talk on Ancient Indian Knowledge System. Speaking on that he told that India has long tradition of gaining knowledge & reaching out to wisdom. He further said that the present day students should know the legacy so that they can be inspired to achieve the height of their ancestor & make India once again the VISHWAGURU. He provided some tips for the students to prove themselves as good learners.

Mr. Dharmendra Singh, Member of Pharmacy Council of India addressed the students and expressed his good wishes. He emphasized about Pharmacy Council of India (PCI) which regulatory body is designing the Education Regulations pertaining to Pharmacy which outlines the conditions to be followed by pharmacy colleges, Institutions and Universities. He also

discussed about different domain of Pharmaceutical Sciences, Students can pursue bachelor's degree programmer, diploma programmer, master degree programmer and doctoral-level programmer. The COVID-19 situation has really put a spotlight on the ability of the pharmaceutical and biotechnology industries to do well and to address the global pandemic. He explained that this positive attention—and the speed at which these pharmaceutical science organizations have addressed the worldwide health crisis—have led to increased career opportunities for professionals.

UNIVERSAL HUMAN VALUES

Mr. Arvind Kumar Pandey, HOD SEIT, ARKA JAIN University handled the third session on Universal Human Values. In his talk, he said that for the all-round development of students may be ensured through inculcating universal human values & would make them human beings in real terms. India continues to play a material role in manufacturing various critical, high-quality and low-cost medicines for Indian and global markets. In the current Scenario the demand of medicines is increasing day by day, so the employment in pharma sector is also rising.

Mr. Sudipto Mondal, Senior Analyst, Novartis, Hyderabad chaired the second session. He works as a key resource in project. He expertise in Protocol writing, to prepare and perform search strategy in Ovid database, grey literature searches, screening of abstracts and full text articles, free text searches, extraction (published articles, HTA,CSR), quality check of data, reports (Clinical, Economic, Epidemiology). He delivered his talk on the topic Overview on Health economics and outcome Research



CAREER & PLACEMENT

Mr. Himanshu Kumar Sinha Training & Placement Head delivered his talk on Career guidance. In the rising demand of pharma Industry in India, Pharma students have oceans of career opportunities Hospital pharmacist & Manager, Community Pharmacist Drug Control Administrator, Drug Inspector, Pharmaceutical Marketing Representative, Research Manager, Health Inspector, Chemical Analyst, Drug Technician, Drug Therapist, Customs Officer, Pharma Data Analyst, Trainer, Assistant Professor, Food and Drug Administrator, Hospital Drug Administrator, etc. there are plenty of options to choose career wisely. He also discussed about successful job application which requires three things: (1) having a good motivation, (2) having the required technical skill set and (3) being able to illustrate your interpersonal skills. NSS ACTIVITIES



17th September 2021, 3rd Day AARAMBH 21




Mr. Anil Prasad Singh, President of Jharkhand State Pharmacy Council addressed the fresher students and expresses his best wishes for their bright future.

YOGA



The Meeting was started at 3:30 pm under the Chairmanship of Dr. Jyotirmaya Sahoo. Dr. Sahoo welcomed all the members.

Agenda 1: Objective of meeting Decision: Discussed and updated

Dr. Sahoo explained the objective of meeting. He said Mentoring is a very important role for the success of a student. All the five fingers are not equal. Students which develop strong mentoring relationships tend to be more productive and participative in various activities. A student is not only to do excel in academics. Mentoring helps to search the potentiality within the students, their strong points and simultaneously how to complete their course work and industrial training successfully.

Agenda 2: Philosophy of Mentoring

Decision: Discussed and updated

The purpose of mentoring is overall development of the student. Understanding and trust is the main focus on which mentor and mentee can remain successful on setting goals, making decision, solving problem and achieving goals. This is because both mentor and mentee gain experience as it's about not teaching but learning.

- During first meeting with mentee, the mentor should explain about the relationship between mentor-mentee. How it will be beneficial in both way of participation in co-curricular, social, cultural & sports activities, community service projects, tutoring, *etc* apart from regular teaching & learning.
- Mentor should explore the hidden interest of mentee in which he/she can do well.
- The mentors interest should also realised or feel by the Mentee.
- Mentor should also address their background and attempt to identify their strengths and weaknesses. This information will help to set the goal for the mentee for his/her academic activity and career.
- After analysis of the information/feedback given by mentee, the mentor shall guide the mentee.
- Mentor should also understand that while designing any project/educational activity for them, the goals might differ from their opinion. Such type of student's aspects should be addressed positively.
- In case a mentee is disappointed due to negative results in examinations or projects, it's the mentor's responsibility to motivate and offer proper guidance in light of their weakness. So that their future goals can be achieved.
- At least two meetings with the mentee for update of activity should be taken by the mentor in every semester.
