




With the blessings of almighty, we welcomed the Batch of 2021 with Aarambh 2021 – 5 day - Orientation Program.








Day 1 - AARAMBH 2021, 1st October, Friday



This was followed by a graceful welcome dance video prepared by a student of BA Journalism and Mass Communication.








Day 2 - AARAMBH 2021, 4th October, Monday


Mr.JasbirDhanjal addressed the students with his motivating words and welcomed one and all to the Arka Jain family.





Our guests for the day – from CII – Yi – Mr. Rahul Pasar and Harsh, gave a real time industry prep talk to the kids.



Our next session was the much-awaited Departmental Introduction. The program coordinations of each department introduced the students to each department – the working, curriculum, activities, and introduction to each department.









It was an important session as it formally allowed the students to interact with their faculty and guides. The day was formally closed with the National Anthem.




Day 4 - AARAMBH 2021, 6th October, Wednesday



The students were addressed by our honourable Vice Chancellor, Director Campus and Dean – School of Health and Allied Science.






Dr. Manoj Pathak gave a brief about the NSS team and its activities. Students were also urged to join this community and be a part of this social change.
