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INTRODUCTION

ARKA Jain University, School of Engineering & IT organized a 5 days induction program "AARAMBH 2020" for the fresh entrants to Engibeering programs, in line with the AICTE requirements. 

Literary Events


Brief Report: A quiz always increases knowledge and stirs curiosity. Literary events consisted of 5 section. Each section representing a different vista.



All the singers, it is time to pull up your socks as solo singing challenge is coming your way. You have the chance to exhibit your singing skills.


- Participants are required to submit a Solo Singing competition registration before the registration deadline.
