Drug abuse refers to the use of certain chemicals for the purpose of creating pleasurable effects on the brain. According to an estimate about 7 million people in India are victims of drug addiction which needs to be returned to the mainstream of the society.

Prof (Dr) SS Razi said that in the last few years the use of drugs and narcotic drugs for intoxication is increasing in India and it has taken the form of a formidable problem.

Dr. Santosh Singh delivered the welcome address in the meeting and said that the person who consumes drugs is not only affected personally, but his entire family and society are affected by it.
