


Report on Kangri An outreach for Homeless People to distribute Warm Clothes in the winter Held on – 22.12.2021

Kangri means a small pot filled with lighted charcoal, used to transport fire or (in Kashmir) carried close to the body as a means of keeping warm. As stated with the norms of Pharmacy Council of India, the approved institutes should go for outreach programs for the benefit of society as well as to educate and aware the pharmacy students to realise their role for the wellness of society. This time it was planned to present with the homeless people to share their pain.
