## **Community Field Visit**


On 17th February 2022, the department of School of Nursing faculties visited at Mohanpur village which is situated at near Arka Jain University. The purpose of the Community visit was to educate the people in the community area about the personal hygiene .Also, the primary care to be taken after a snake bite. Their knowledge was assessed and noted, many of them are still go to Ojha and getting other modes of treatment after being bitten by snake. Apart from this, we learnt that they are disposing garbage into an open place. Then, Asst.prof.Salma Soren and Ms.Anuradha Soren explained the importance of hygiene and the diseases caused by improper personal hygiene. Children were more excited and they were very interested to accept the hand washing techniques. Aware them about benefits of sleep and suggested them to incorporate some activities in their daily living life. The necessity of wearing the mask was discussed .Fortuitously, corona virus cases have not been detected yet.

Ms Pārbati Mardi shared the knowledge about the services to be done if the snake bites by using charts. She emphasized on reducing anxiety during the incident and how to handle the situation in right way. After the health talk, with the help of

questionnaire tools their knowledge were evaluated and observed the changes in them. Followed by, gave them a chance of asking their doubts. However, some of them asked their doubts that were resolved. To inspire personal hygiene, soaps were distributed. All were satisfied with this awareness programme and they also recommended us to come and organize these type of activities in future. Finally, we thank to everyone who made this event successful.
