Participants raised many questions and provided comments. Some students even clarified their doubts in a one on one conversation. The distinguished panel members ensured that they **patiently answered to all the questions elaborately.**

The key statements, quotes and points:

- 1. "What are the most critical skills the industries demand from the fresher's or a New Employee?"
- **2.** The speaker **Shri Ranjan Kumar Mahapatra** talked about the 3 A's the fresher should have that are Adaptability, Availability & Acceptability.
- **3.** The speaker talked about the 3 C's the fresher should have: Collaboration, Compassion & Cooperation.
- **4.** The first speaker Shri Ranjan Kumar Mahapatra talked about the 3 A's along importance of changing the people attitude.
- **5.** Mr. Ranjan Kumar Mahapatra also talked about what the companies do with their employees, the importance of building care, innovation, passion, trust with existing employees the fresher's/New Employee.
- 6. The second speaker Mr. Hari Govinda Tilak talked about the importance of Attitude over aptitude.
- 7. Mr. Tilak also said that in order to achieve something good the individual should come out of his/her comfort zone. Attitude & Behaviour cannot be shaped in a short time and it can only be nurtured over a period of time. Attitude is most superior to anything else. He used the proverb "Opportunity knocks only once at the door". He shared the story of Carry Kindle (IBM). He also mentioned letter of positivity cannot be given to anyone, the individual will have to motivate them self for the same.
- **8.** The 3rd speaker Prof. (Dr.) Vinita Sahay talked about helping the students to prepare themselves about the organisation they are joining in or about their dream organisation they wish to join.
- **9.** Prof. (Dr.) Vinita Sahay talked about the importance of rewarding and recognizing the people with empathy.
- **10.** Employees should be rewarded for maintaining good behaviour with their colleagues.
- **11.** The fourth speaker Dr. Mehul G Thakkar talked about the ethics that one should have and the passion and belief which one must have on his or herself. Perfection and patience is the two important keys to it.
- **12.** One of the most asked questions during the interview which was (Tell me something about yourself) was answered by the speakers so that the student come to know the important points which they should mention while answering this question during the interview.
- **13.** The panel members talked about the legacy of core values.
- **14.** The speakers talked about building ethical values among the new and upcoming generation.
- **15.** The people with good ethical values stop practicing it once they enter their corporate jobs just to adjust with the situation. It should be carried for a long period of time.
- **16.** Ethical values should be the core aspects of every Educational Institute.
