Director Shri Amit Srivastava said that mother tongue is not only the identity of our country but it is also the true conductor, communicator and representative of our values, culture and values.


Director (Campus) cum Dean, Students' Welfare Dr. Angad Tiwari said that what we learn through mother tongue cannot be learned from any other language in the world.
