On the eve of Women's day, The students of BA (H) Fashion Design, Arka Jain University visited the Handicrafts Training Program at Talsa, Sundernagar under "SAMARTH" organized by the Handicrafts Support Centre, Ministry of Textiles, Ranchi, Jharkhand. The women of the Santhal Tribe are being trained for basic embroidery techniques namely – jeera stitch, magar stitch, kaja(buttonhole) stitch, stem stitch, running stitch, kantha and 36 such different types of embroidery. Mr. Kalyan Bhagat, the coordinator at the centre introduced us to the women with whom the students were teamed up to create few embroidery samples. The trainer Ms. Usha showed us the various samples the women had created in small fabrics of cotton, tassar and also the samples being developed on sarees and stoles (both cotton and silk). The hand work of the women was intricate and neat. Even after a short span of training of 15-20 days, such exceptionally fine work was truly commendable. The women spoke in Santhali and Hindi which again was a unique experience for the students. As these days there is not much exposure to the local heritage of our state which is the true essence of our country. The women told us that they drew inspiration of their motifs from their everyday life, surroundings, flora, fauna, wall paintings, etc. Their colour associations were strong even though they have not studied colour theory because of their observation of nature and its elements. We spent a quality time learning embroidery but the culture more. The women while they showed their embroidery techniques also spoke about their culture, the festival Baha, wall paintings and more; it truly was more than just a conventional industry visit. The

students were greatly inspired by what they saw, learned and heard. It was in its true sense a pure design experience. We were also briefed about the project and the everyday working of the centre by Mr. Doman Tudu, the cluster head. Even though the students have had a prior knowledge of embroidery, seeing it on this way at the actual grass root level was an enriching experience. Towards the end of our visit, we also took a tour of the village to visually understand the aesthetic of the village – colours, housing pattern, visual elements and more. Most of the artwork of the houses, done by the villagers were very inspiring and showed their natural talent. The colour combinations were soothing and moreover there was use of natural colours. We talk about sustainability more at a global arena, but in our own country, sustainability in our culture. It was a true delight to visit Talsa and we were highly inspired.
