On 8th April 2022, industrial trip to Uranium Corporation of India Limited (UCIL), Jamshedpur, was organized by Department of Biotechnology, ARKA Jain University in association with CII-Yi for B.Sc. Biotechnology students.

Uranium Corporation of India Limited was incorporated on 4th October 1967. It is a Public Sector Enterprise under the Department of Atomic Energy with a special standing at the forefront of Nuclear Power cycle. It plays a very significant role in India's nuclear power generation program. Thirty B.Sc. Biotechnology students visited the mining area of UCIL to understand the occurrence of uranium and other ores, their mining process, effects of radiation as well as the risk associated with it. Students visited the arch room which consists of six detectors, four are on the side and two are on the ceiling which detects the gamma radiation coming from the ore extracted so that the percentage of uranium can be detected. Dr. Prashant Das, Additional Manager Geological Department, UCIL brief about the purity percentage of uranium which was 0.5% & the amount of uranium extracted. Then, they told about the further processing of grinding and processing & the final sample goes to the lab for the chemical & purity testing.

After the mining area visit, students visited the Health Physical center that is under Bhabha Atomic Research Centre. Mr. B. K Rana, Radiological Safety Officer briefed about the history of Homi Jehangir Bhabha and HBNI. Dr. Sameem showed various laboratories for testing water, soil, air and plants samples taken from the uranium mine area. The students saw the latest laboratory equipment which would be helpful for their research.

The trip was organized under the guidance of Dr. Santosh Kumar Singh, Program coordinator, Department of Biotechnology. Such educational trips are important in

providing real life experiences and developing scientific temperament in the students. Dr. Chandra Prabha Sahu, Dr. Jyoti Khurana, Mr. Rahul Pasari, Mr. Harsh Kedia accompanied the students during the trip.
