LECTURE ON “Importance of MEDIATION”

A lecture was organised by School of Law, Arka Jain University on today’s pivotal subject “Mediation” on 20th of April, 2022. Event was organised by Prof. Dr. Bodhistva Acharya, Dean, School of Law in collaboration with Radanks London and coordinated by Ms. Amrita Shrivastava Asst. Professor.

Objective:-

The session aimed at providing knowledge about the mode of peaceful settlement of dispute, the scope and procedure of Mediation. The technicalities involved in the process of arbitration was thoroughly explained to the students. The objective of the webinar was to inform the students about Mediation that it is a structured, interactive process where an impartial third party assists disputing parties in resolving conflict through the use of specialized communication and negotiation techniques. By this lecture students were also informed that Mediation is an informal and flexible dispute resolution process. The mediator's role is to guide the parties toward their own resolution. Through joint sessions and separate caucuses with parties, the mediator helps both sides define the issues clearly, understand each other's position and move closer to resolution.

Students were also explained the different stages of Mediation are as follows:-

- Introduction and opening statement :-
- Joint Session.
- Separate Session.

- Reaching a settlement.
- Closing.

Stages 1-4 usually take place in order. Other stages, with the exception of the concluding joint session are seen as optional depending on the circumstances. If the matter has not resolved, the mediator will discuss with the parties the next steps to be taken, including the need to obtain any further material. If appropriate, directions may be issued by the Tribunal.

In all ADR processes the parties must act in good faith (section 34A)

Area of Concern- Importance of Mediation, Scope and Procedure.
