The party who alleges the existence of a certain fact has to prove its existence and the party, who denies it, has to disprove its existence or prove its non-existence.

According to eminent legal thinkers like Jeremy Bentham and William Twining the overall aim if the process of adjudication is the "rectitude of decision making". This is achieved by the correct application of substantive law to the true facts in the particular case. In this way; the aims of justice are served.
