## **Objective:-**

International conference on the topic "World Day for International Criminal Justice". The conference aims to throw light on what is understood by the phrase 'international criminal justice' is surprisingly difficult to articulate comprehensively. At a fundamental level, it describes the response of the international community—and other communities—to mass atrocity. Different aspects of the justice system were discussed and how different communities responds differently to the situation.

How we respond to war, to the rupture of society and to systematized murder and persecution, is at the heart of the issue. Which forms of transitional justice we respond with, and how our goals are best achieved, are important questions. But international criminal justice is about more than responses. How do we learn from history or, sometimes, fail to do so or how can we use our understanding of human psychology to better respond to mass atrocity, or better, to prevent it or react to address it sooner. What of the sociological elements that are infused in our response to heinous international crimes and how do these affect our understanding and practice of international criminal justice.
