### LECTURE ON “General Principle of Contract Law”

Group Discussion ‘Revisiting the current regime of family law in India’

On 06.09.2020 a Guest Lecture was arranged by Arka Jain University, by Mahak Rathee, Advocate, Delhi High Court, Founder, ADR HOC and Consumer Assist. in her talk analyzed the Indian Contract Act from section 1-75 and admired the contributions of the scholars who enacted the same.

**Objective:-** The session was aimed at providing knowledge about the Basic Principles of Contract Law. While giving the lecture on Contract Act she stressed various important provisions of the Act such as Sec: 11, Sec: 10, sec:25, sec: 28, sec:35, sec:65, sec: 75 and elaborated certain important concepts such as offer, acceptance, communication, the capacity to contract, void contract, Voidable contract, void agreement, frustration of contract, and, coercion, fraud, misrepresentation, mistake with humorous illustration. In the interaction session she had answered the questions asked by the students related to the Contract Act. It was a thrilling exercise to the student community and it was highly appreciated by the students regarding the English language and Vocabulary of the Resource person.
