A session of power point presentation was conducted on 7th July 2022 on 'American Poetry' for the SEM II (2021 batch) as a class activity in the Seminar Hall of Block C of the University. The event was coordinated by the subject teacher Dr. Manoj Kumar Pathak. In his opening remarks on American Poetry he said that American poetry in general is about themes such as possibility, democracy, national identity, and love. American poets steered poetry toward greater density, difficulty, and opacity, with an emphasis on techniques such as fragmentation, ellipsis, allusion, juxtaposition, ironic and shifting personae, and mythic parallelism.


The students of Sem II presented on the eminent poets namely, Emily Dickinson, Elizabeth Bishop, Maya Angelou, Walt Whitman, and Anne Bradstreet.

There was a discussion made on Louis Simpson's poem 'American Poetry' which is about the nature and range of the poems written by great American poets. In this poem, he captures the wide array of topics that are displayed through their poems. The poem was first published in 1963.

The students recited poems like Success is Countest Sweetest, One Art, Hope is the Thing with Feather, Still I Rise, The Flesh and the Spirit, Leaves of Grass. They recited the poems, briefed about the respective poets and critically analyzed for the audience of Sem II and V.

At the end Dr. Manoj Kumar Pathak shared his opinions on the presentations and appreciated the efforts made by the students.
