OBJECTIVE: Strategies for translating health research into practice, including effective dissemination and implementation strategies for research findings also to address the global health challenges, including infectious diseases, non-communicable diseases, and environmental health risks, and exploring innovative solutions for improving health outcomes worldwide.

DETAILS: School of Pharmacy, ARKA JAIN University, India in collaboration with School of Allied Health Sciences, Pharmacy department, San Pedro College, Philippines & MOU Partners; IQAC, IIC and RDC of AJU conducted a 5 days International Conference from 2nd May 2023 to 6th May 2023. The conference was inaugurated by the vice chancellor of ARKA JAIN University and other dignitaries from different institutions virtually with spiritual lamp lighting and Saraswati Vandana. The sacred flag bearing the symbol of pharmacy was hoisted in the presence of Chief Speaker Mr Dharmendra Singh, Executive Committee Member of Pharmacy Council of India; student participants and faculty members. The welcome note read by Dr Manoj Pathak, Associate Professor from Department of English, ARKA JAIN University. Prof. Jacqueline Padilla, Dean, Pharmacy Department, San Pedro College, Philippines and Prof. Dr. Erwin M. Faller, Director, Professor, Pharmacy Department, San Pedro College, Philippines; Dr Priyambada Kshiroda nandini Sarangi, Director, Holy Grace Academy of Pharmacy, Kerala and Dean of School of Pharmacy ARKA JAIN University, India addressed participants and briefed about the theme of the conference. The Chief Speaker focused on the implementation of a modern education system to meet the Industry requirements. He gave his valuable insights about quality in higher education. Guest of Honour Dr. D.K. Tripathi emphasised on revision of syllabus, practical research, steps taken by PCI, role of health care professionals.

He suggested ways in which researchers could improve themselves and give their contributions for Society benefit. Chief Guest Dr. Montukumar M Patel, President PCI told about technology transfer, Covid-19 vaccine, Challenges of Pharmacy profession & its impact on Nation as well as global development, ADR, Pharmacovigilance practice in India. He also emphasised on Higher education institutions are increasingly viewed as economic engines by policy makers and are seen as essential for ensuring knowledge production through research and innovation. He also appreciated the effort for the betterment of the students and faculties as well as industry persons. The inaugural session of the International

Conference 2023 ended with cultural performance by the students and National Anthem of Philippines and India. The resources from industries and academia from both the countries shared their expertise on the theme Global Health Challenges & Translating Research into Practice. About 280 participants and more than 40 institutions from both the countries participated in the conference. Finally vote of thanks was given by Mr Sumanta Sen the Associate Professor of School of Pharmacy, ARKA JAIN University, India. The Director Mr. Amit Shrivastav, Registrar Mr. Jasbir Singh Dhanjal, Dean Student Welfare Dr. Angad Tiwary, Ms Chief Finance & Account Officer Richa Garg appreciated the effort by School of Pharmacy. In 1st session of 5-days International Conference, Dr. Harish Choudhary gave talk on Black Moon in Health care. He discussed about Global Health challenges, Pandemic of NCD & Infectious diseases, anti-microbial resistance, Access to health care, climate change, pollution, nutrition and Health hazards, and aging population. In 1st session of Day - 2, Dr. Nagaraj Rao, Managing Director, Rane Rao Reshamia Laboratories Pvt Ltd, Navi Mumbai, Indiashared his view on Difference between Research and Development. He explained that Research tasks are aimed at generation or expansion of knowledge whereas development tasks have as their objective the physical output of new products or processes. In 2nd Scientific session, Dr. Vivien Leigh P. Mina Pharmacology Department, Mindanao State University-General Santos, Philippines gave talk on Efficacy and Safety of Molnupiravir in Adult Patient with COVID-19: a Systematic Review and Meta-Analysis. She reviewed safety and efficacy of Molnupiravir in SARS-COV-2 infections. Data collected from literature from clinical studies showed that Molnupiravir caused significant reduction in the risk of hospitalization or death in high-risk mild COVID-19 patients. Molnupiravir was also found to be well tolerated and safe without any major adverse events on short-term use. For confirmative use of this drug in mild-to-moderate COVID-19 disease, further studies are required.

In 3rd Scientific session, Prof. Fatima May Tesoro, President, Mindanao Alliance of Pharmacy School/ Dean, School of Allied Health Sciences, San Pedro College, Philippines gave talk on TINUBDAN-Research and Community Engagement Tandem: Our Ways Forward in Navigating through COVID Era. She discussed about medicines access, patient medicine education, product development from natural sources, Ethanobotanical potentials, and eco business of nutraceuticals.

In 1st session of Day -3, Dr. Ma. Eloisa P. Espanola, College Dean, Holy Child Central Colleges, South Cotabato, Philippines gave talk on Antibody Titer due to COVID-19 Vaccination of Pfizer among Individuals with Diabetes mellitus: A Systematic Review and MetaAnalysis. She dicussed regarding immune response in T2DM patients to vaccines. She systematically explored the SARS-CoV-2 antibody response or seropositivity among DM patients following the COVID-19 vaccine. In 2nd Scientific session, Professor (Dr.) Pratap Kumar Sahu, School of Pharmaceutical Sciences, S'O'A University, Bhubaneswar, India gave talk on Free radicals and neurodegeneration: Repurposing with Sartans. He briefly explained about free radicals and oxidants play a dual role as both toxic and beneficial compounds, since they can be either harmful or helpful to the body. The link between mid-life hypertension and onset of AD is well-studied. Having established a clear correlation between hypertension and AD. Treatment with ARBs was reported to slow cognitive decline and reduce the conversion to the AD of patients. ARBs are highly effective in slowing the progress of AD in comparison to other AHT, including ACE inhibitors. He concluded his session by giving emphasis on role of Ang-II which facilitates the production of A β , a few of the reported effects of ARBs include clearance of A β and reduction of A β oligomerization. In 3rd Scientific session, Dr. Marilou Vicente Tablizo, University of the Immaculate Conception,

Philippines discussed on the topic A systematic review of the medicinal benefits of the phytochemical constituents of passion fruit (*Passiflora edulis*) in non-communicable diseases. She systematically explored various chemical constituents and phytonutrients including polyphenols, dietary fiber, pectin, carotenes, and vitamin of Passion fruit. She gave insight into numerous pharmacological activities including antioxidant, analgesic and anti-inflammatory, antimicrobial, anti-hypertensive, hepatoprotective and lung-protective, anti-tumor, antidiabetic, hypolipidemic, antidepressant and anxiolytic-like capacities of passion fruit, and thus are used in phyto-therapeutic remedies. In 1st session of Day-4, Prof. Dr. Erwin M. Faller Professor, Pharmacy Department, San Pedro College, provided insights on the topic Efficacy of Nirmatrelvir & Ritonavir Combination Treatment for COVID-19 in Adults: A Systematic Review and Meta-Analysis. He concluded that Nirmatrelvir–ritonavir can reduce the mortality and hospitalization of COVID-19 patients compared with other antiviral drugs and further large-scale studies remain to validate these findings. In 2nd Scientific session, Dr. Chita Ranjan Sahoo, ICMR-Centenary Post Doctorate Fellow, Department of Health Research, Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, Government of India shed light on Sea to Pharmacy: current prospects on AMR. He explained rapid increase in pathogenic microorganisms with antimicrobial resistant profiles has become a significant public health problem globally. He emphasised on issue is vital for humans' wellbeing, thus innovative and meticulous actions on the application of various drug delivery approaches to deliver those novel antimicrobial compounds. So, there is a need to precisely design the delivery systems for different types of infectious diseases to prevent the emergence of antimicrobial-resistant pathogens towards the newly developed antimicrobial agents.

In the end, careful considerations in the development of cost-effective novel antimicrobials and highly effective drug delivery systems shall offer substantial benefits for all parties, including research institutes, pharmaceutical industries, health providers, and public communities. In 3rd Scientific session, Professor (Dr) G P Mohanta, Former HOD Annamalai University, Chidambaram, Tamil Nadu gave talk on Pharmacoeconomics: a concern for drug therapy! He discussed out economic relationship which combines the drug research, its production and distribution, storage, pricing, and further use by the people. Pharmacoeconomics can be of tremendous help in decision-making when evaluating the affordability of and access to the right medication to the right patient at the right time when comparing two drugs in the same therapeutic class of drugs. He concluded that proper application of pharmaco-economics will allow the pharmacy practitioners and administrators to make better and more informed decisions regarding products and services they provide. The aspirants presented their research works on day 5. Professor (Dr) Sudhir Kumar was the reviewer; More than 30 abstracts were presented. The International Conference was remained successful with the support of all participants, students and MOU partners.

OUTCOMES: Encourages and promotes multidisciplinary collaboration among laboratory and clinical researchers. Increase surveillance and early detection of drug-resistant microorganisms and novel zoonotic diseases can be the solution for global health challenges.

VALEDICTORIAN REMARKS: The International Conference on the topic Global Health Challenges & Translating Research into Practice was indeed a step in the right direction on the virtue of the contemporary nature of the topic. The congregation of intellectual capital from across the nation as well as from international stalwarts reflected upon the erudite discourse which took place during the conference. It was indeed a momentous occasion in the annals of the University to have representation from Pharmacy intelligentsia. OBJECTIVE
 Translational research has a variety of definitions, but commonly is considered research that translates new information or knowledge that is created in one area to another application. Translational research is a bidirectional process that involves multidisciplinary integration among basic, clinical, practice, population, and policy-based research. The goal of translational research is to speed up scientific discovery into patient and community benefit. This is key concepts, methods, and trial types in translational research. The primary focus is on dissemination and implementation (D&I) research, or the systematic study of processes and factors that lead to widespread use and successful integration of evidence-based interventions into real-world clinical and community settings. 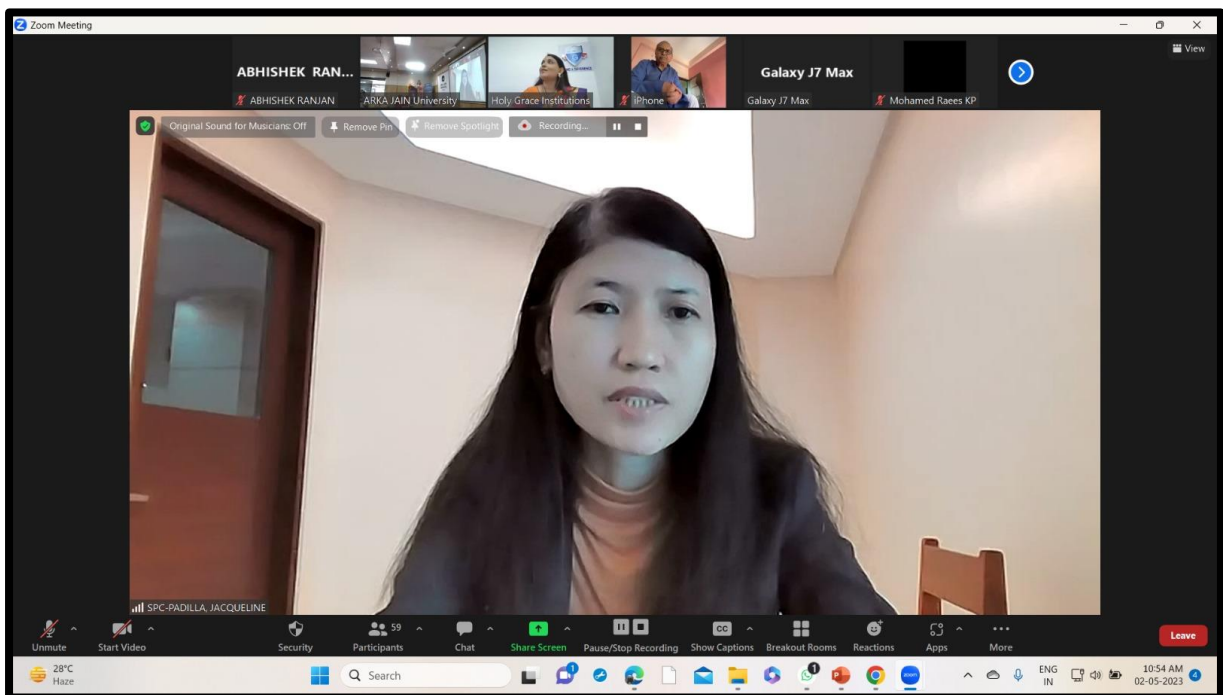


Figure 10: Address by Prof. Jacqueline Padila, Dean Pharmacy Department San Pedro College, Philippines

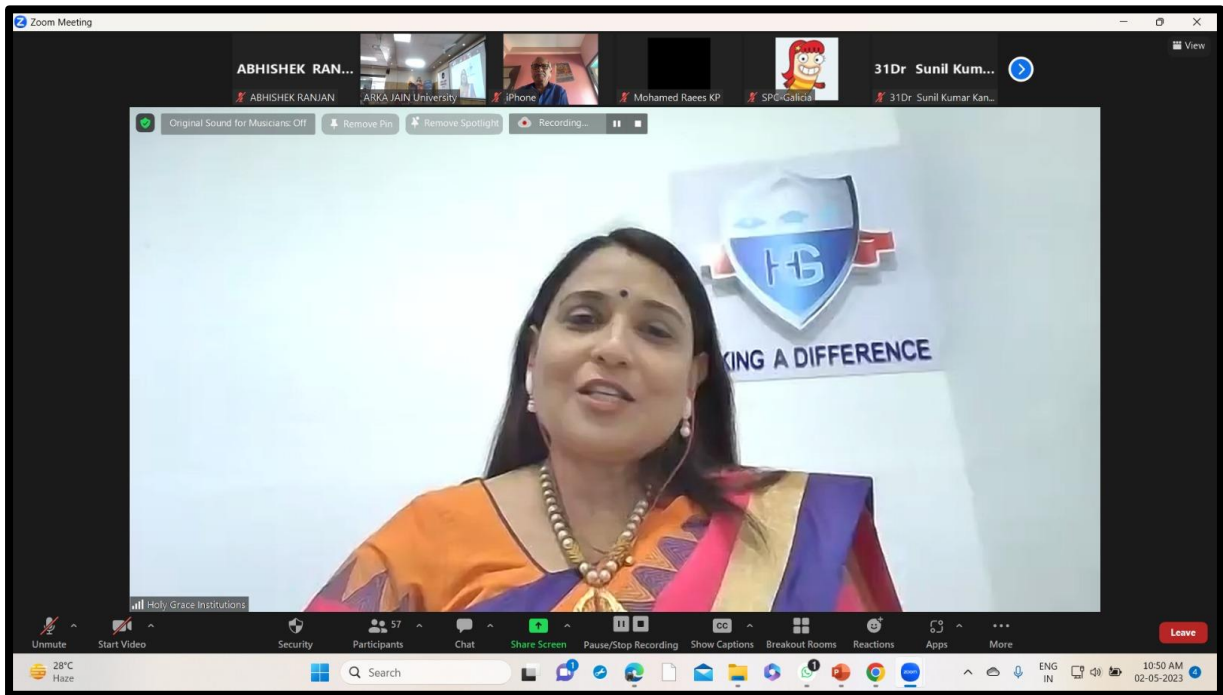


Figure 11: Address by Prof. (Dr.) Priyambada Kshirodanandini Sarangi, Director, Holy Grace Academy, Thrissur, Kerala, India

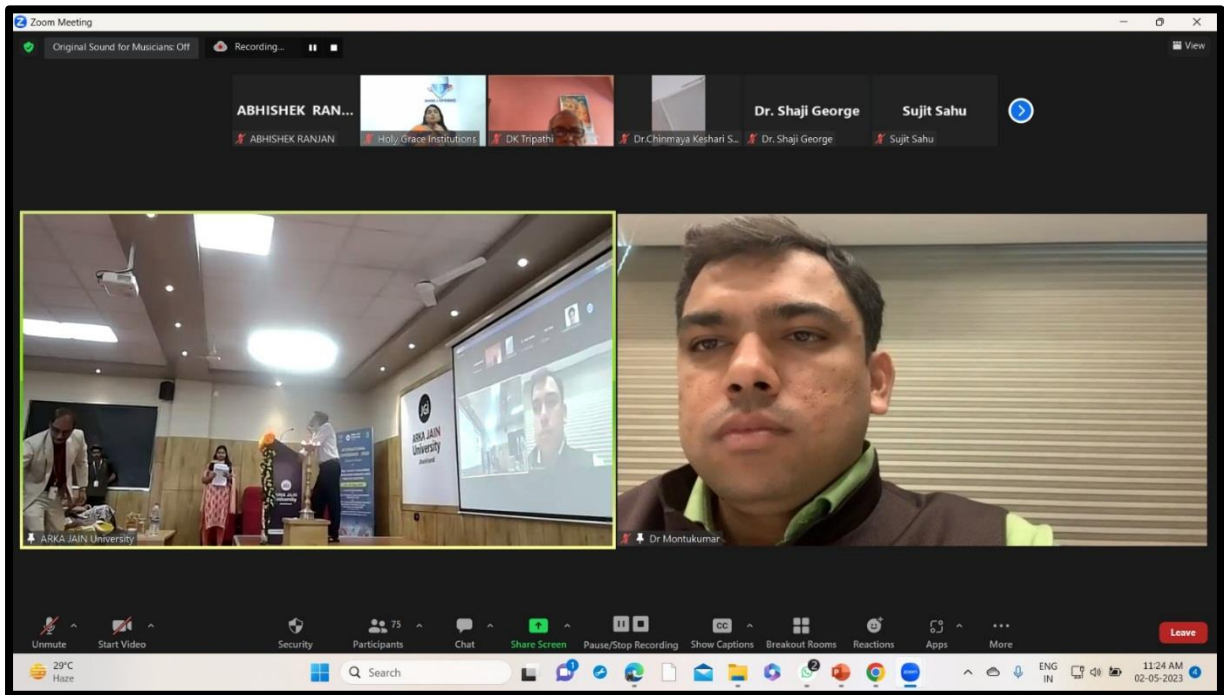


Figure 13: Address by Chief Guest Dr. Montukumar M.Patel President Pharmacy Council of India, New Delhi

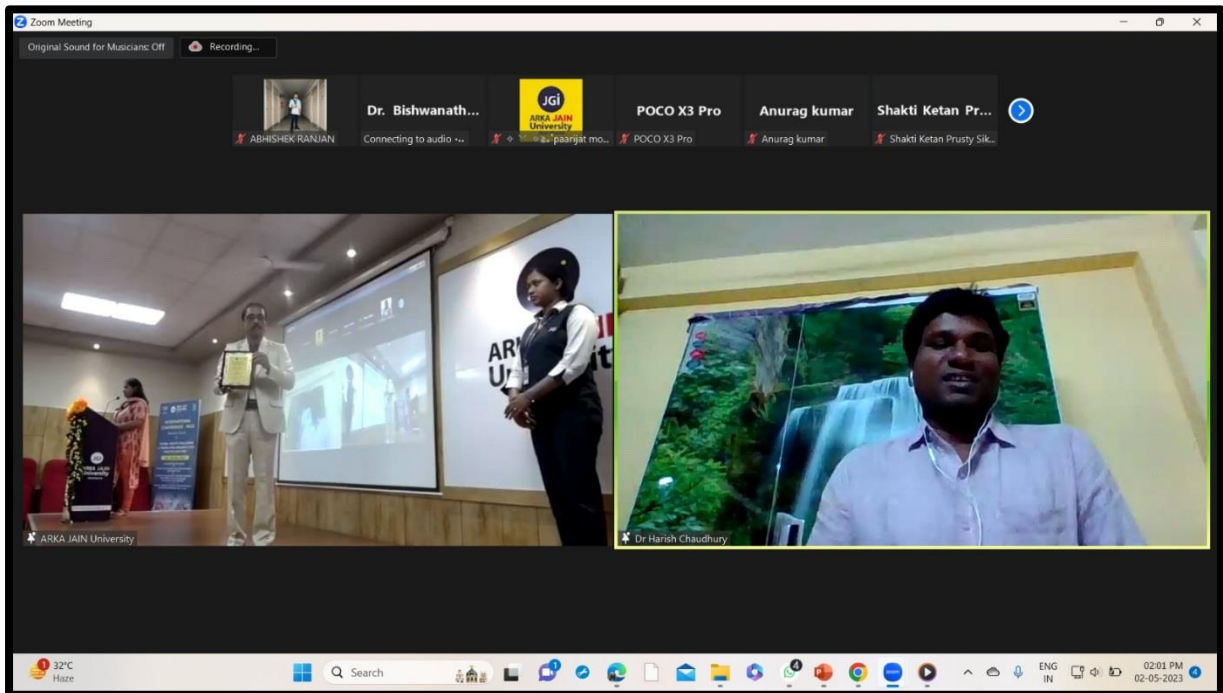


Figure 17: Dr. Harish Choudhury Senior Medical consultant at KIMS, Senior Medical consultant at KIMS, Bhubaneswar, India the day 1 resource

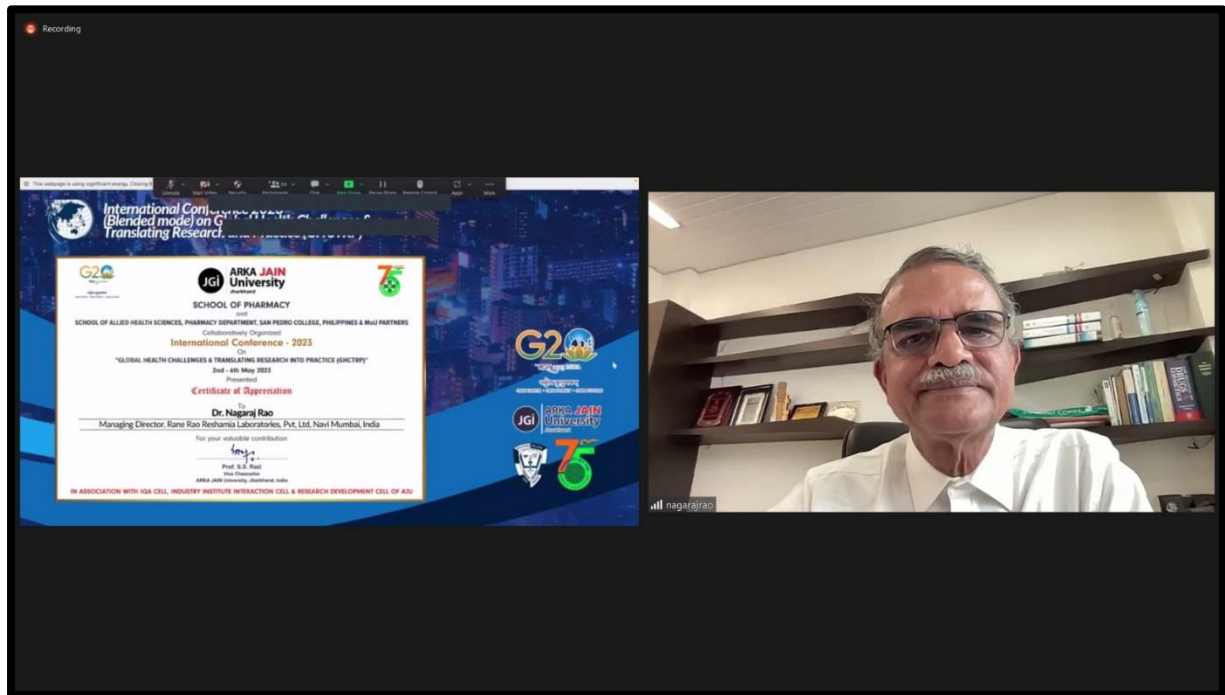


Figure 19: Dr. Nagaraj Rao Managing Director Rane Rao Reshamia Laboratories Pvt Ltd, India (MOU Partner) resource of the day 2 session

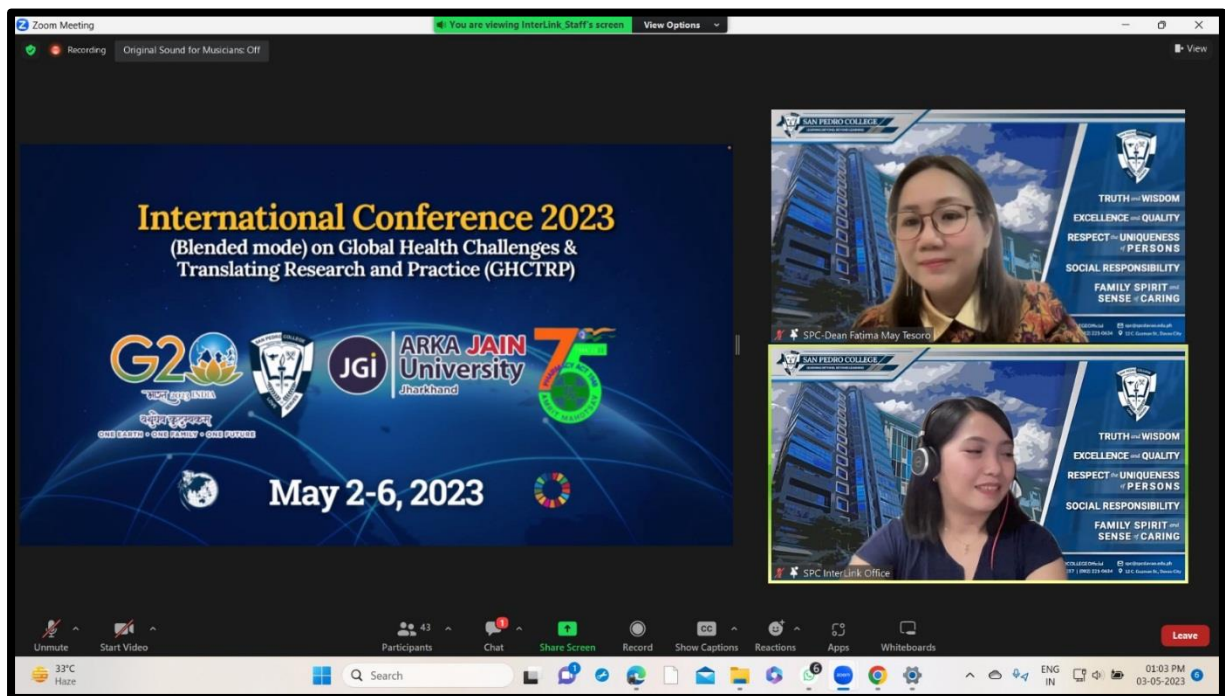


Figure 20: Prof. Fatima May Tesoro President, Mindanao Alliance of Pharmacy School/ Dean, School of Allied Health the resource for day 2 session Sciences, San Pedro College, Philippines

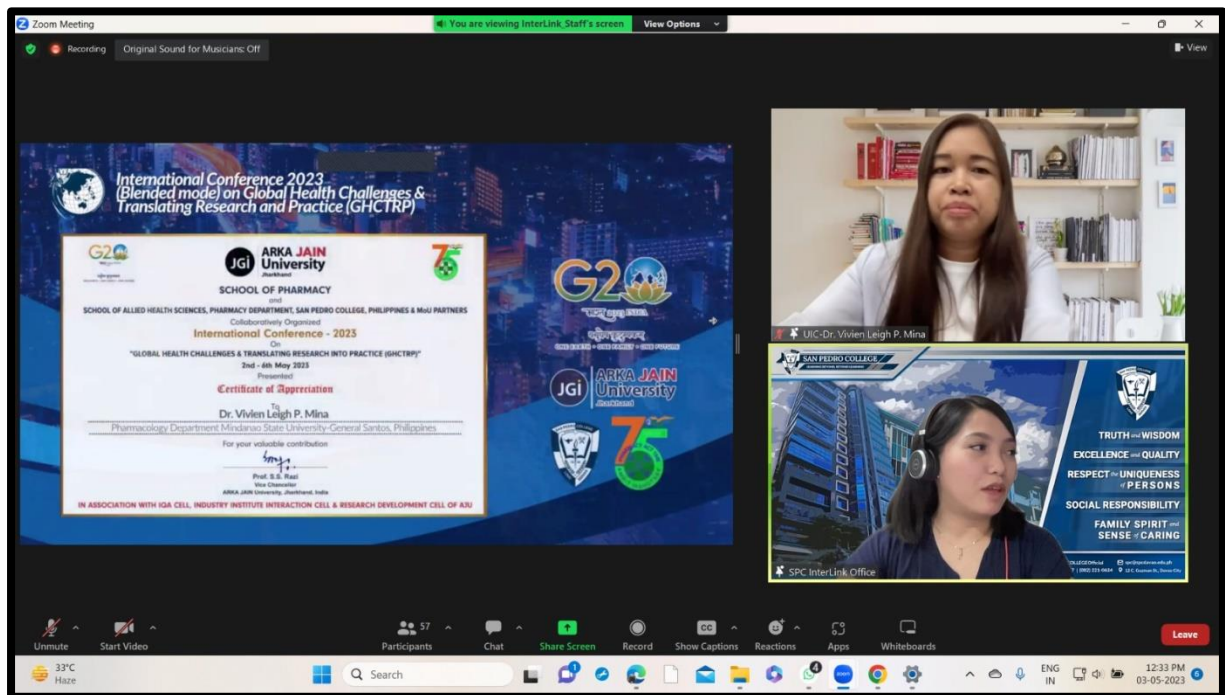


Figure 21: Mina Dr. Vivien Pharmacology Department, Mindanao State University-General Santos, Philippines/PhD, University of the Immaculate Conception, Philippines the resource of day 2 session

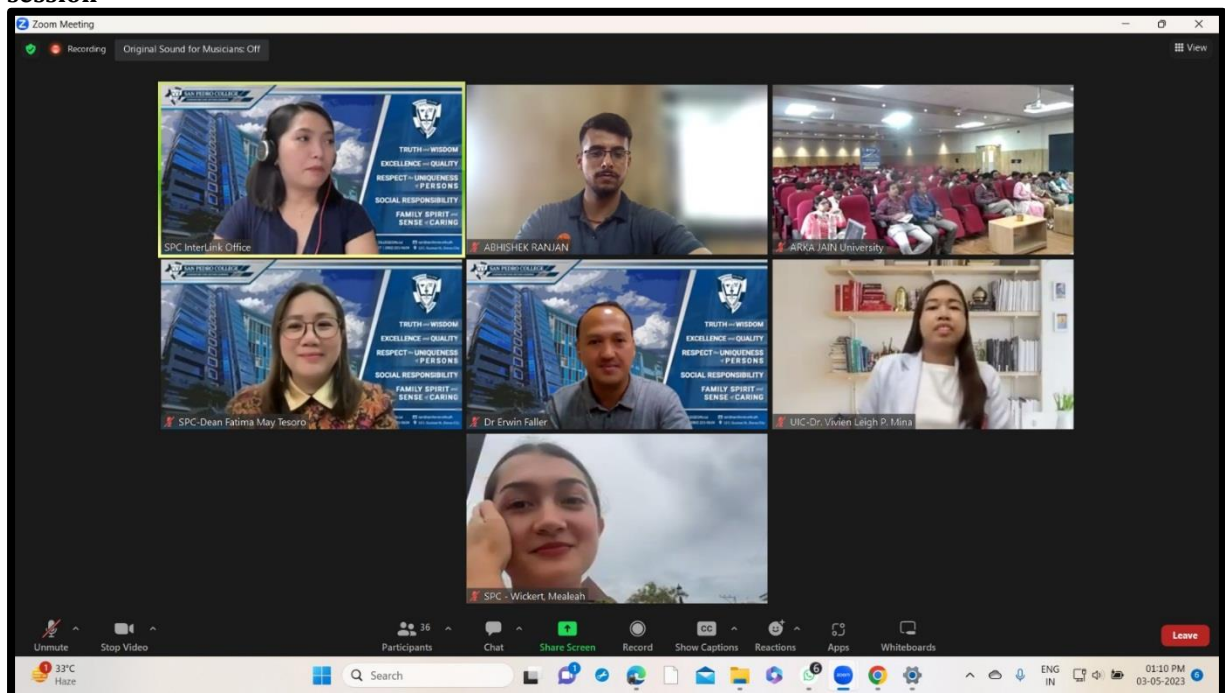


Figure 22: Both countries under one frame

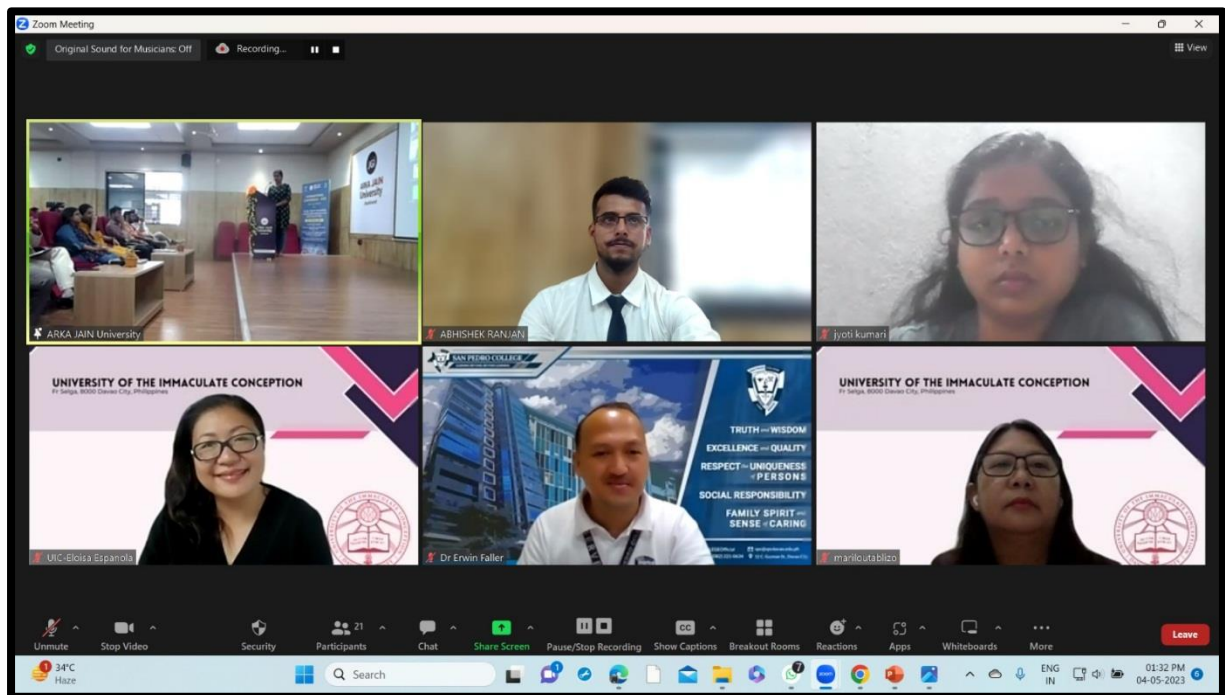


Figure 23: Dr. Ma. Eloisa P. Espanola & Dr. Marilou Vicente Tablizo Child Central Colleges, South Cotabato, Philippines/ PhD, University of the Immaculate Conception, Philippines

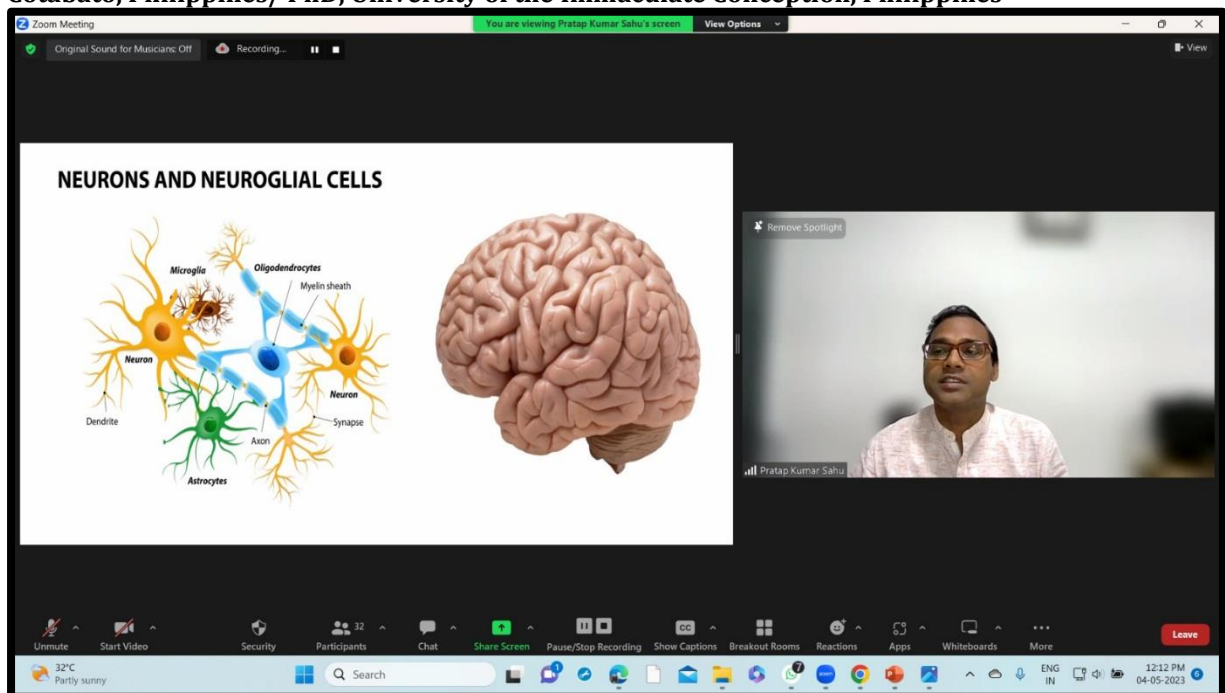


Figure 24: Professor (Dr.) Pratap Kumar Sahu School of Pharmaceutical Sciences, S'O'A University, Bhubaneswar, India presenting 3rd day session

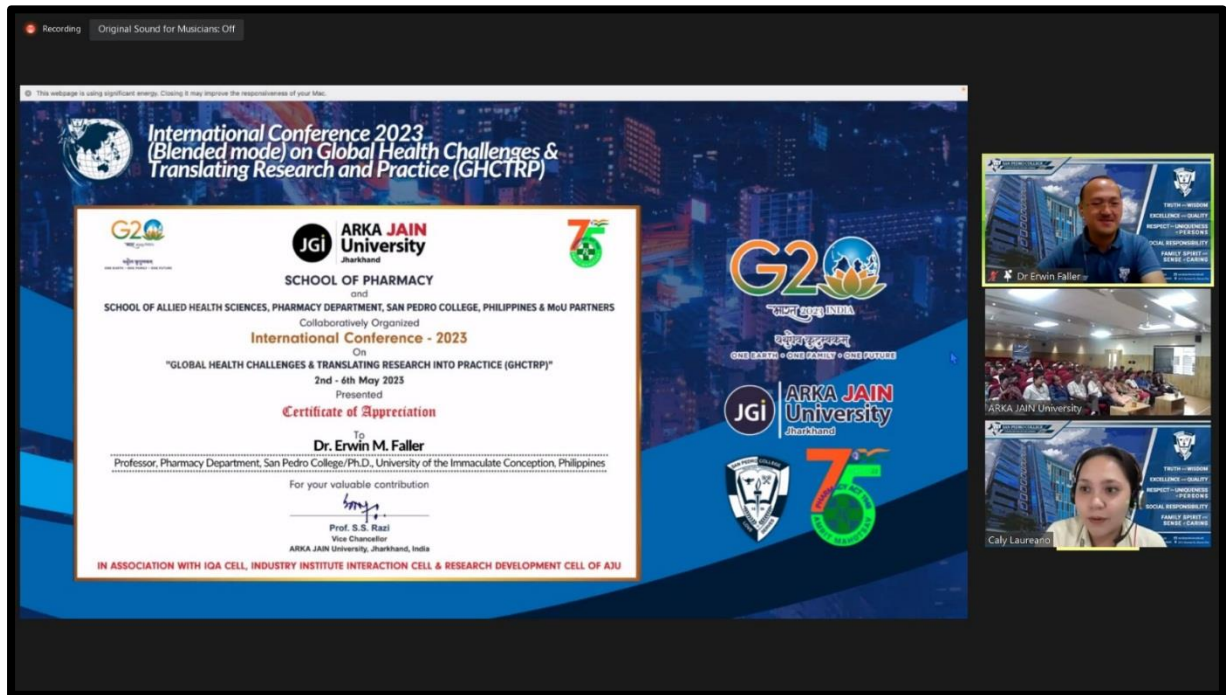


Figure 25: Prof. Dr. Erwin M. Faller presenting a topic in 4th day session

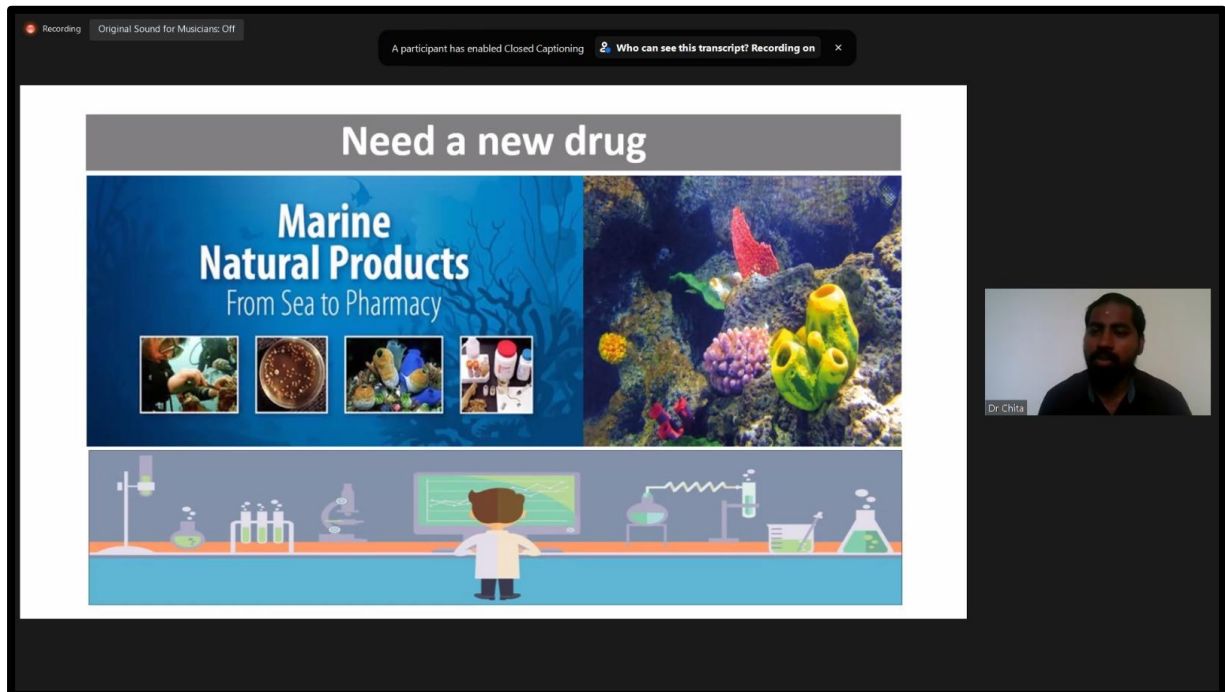


Figure 26: Dr. Chita Ranjan Sahoo presenting a session in 4th day conference

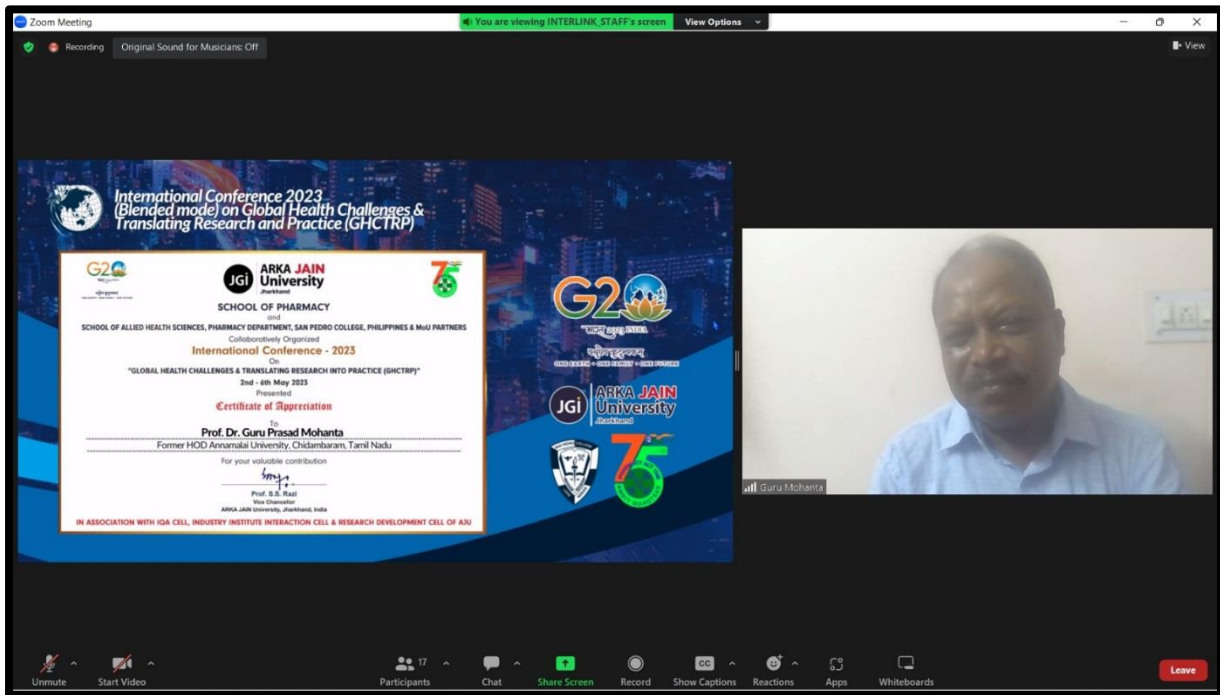


Figure 27: After delivering a Session by Professor (Dr) G P Mohanta

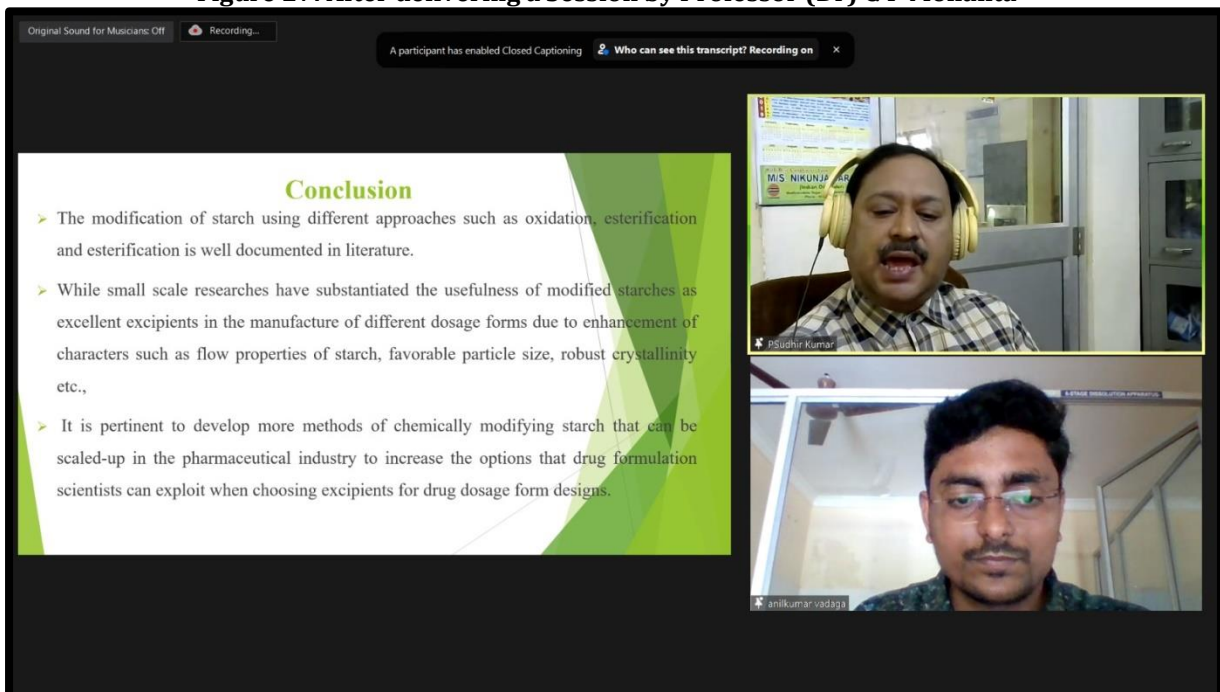


Figure 28: Professor (Dr) P. Sudhir Kumar the reviewer expert to the International Conference 2023

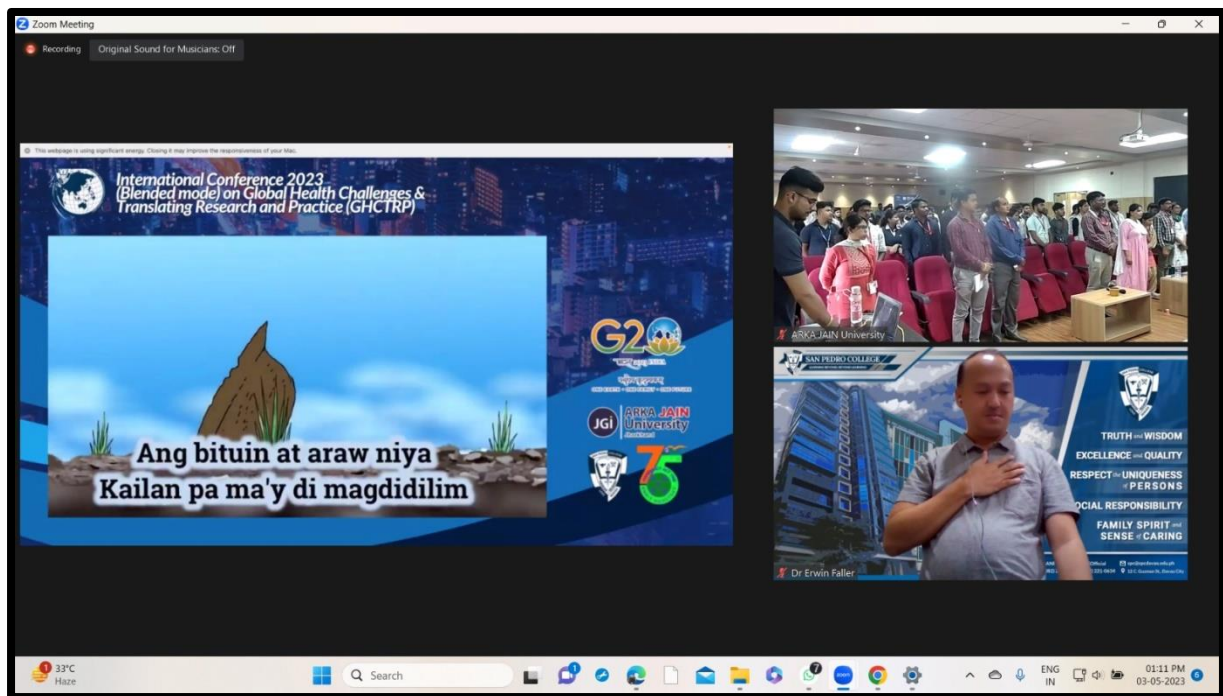


Figure 29: Session ended Philippines National Anthem

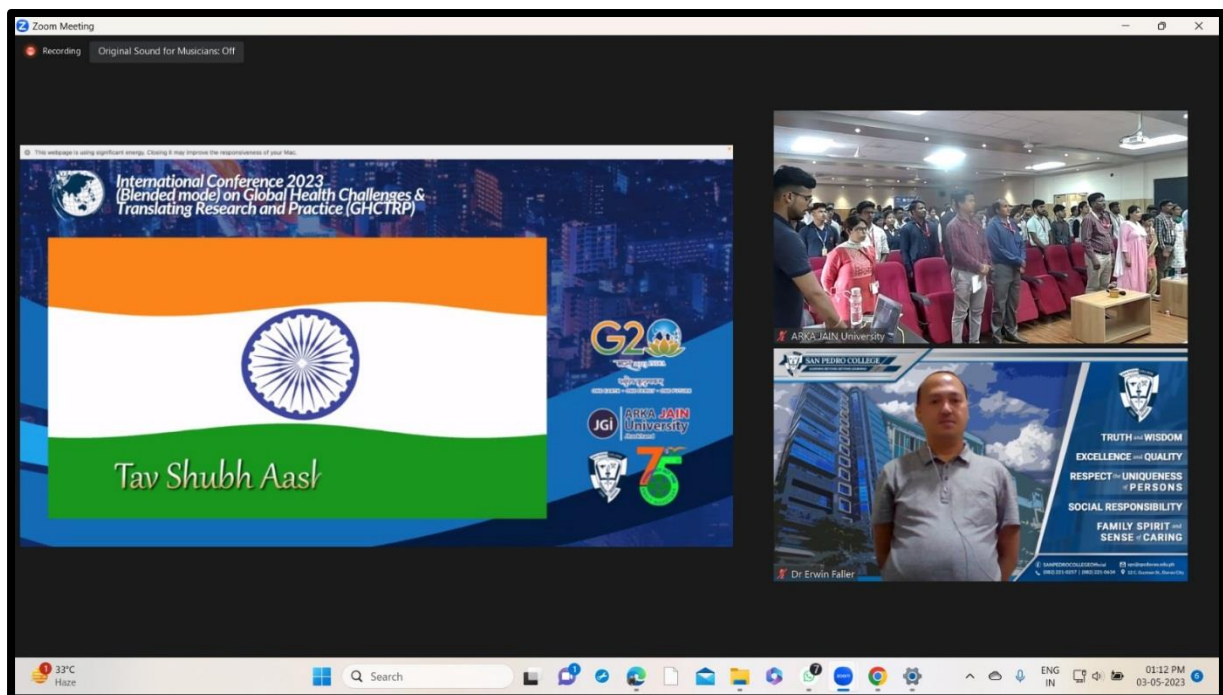


Figure 30: Session ended with Indian national anthem
