### **OBJECTIVE:**

The primary objective of students visiting an old age home is to promote empathy, respect, and understanding. Through direct interactions with elderly residents, students learn to empathize with their needs, show respect for older generations, and gain a deeper understanding of aging-related challenges, fostering a more compassionate and inclusive society.

### **DETAILS:**

Looking into the importance of life skills and values among the students, BHESAJAM, The Pharma club of School of Pharmacy at ARKA JAIN UNIVERSITY, in association with NCC & NSS at ARKA JAIN UNIVERSITY, organized an old age home visit called "**PYAR BANTTE CHALO- Episode 3**". On the **19<sup>th</sup> September, 2023** a group of students from the School of Pharmacy, ARKA JAIN UNIVERSITY, embarked on a heartwarming visit to **Nirmal Hriday, Baridih**, via bus provided by the university at 9 am. The purpose of our visit was to spread love, companionship, and joy among the elderly residents of the old age home. The students carried along with them various goodies, including fruits, biscuits, bread, juice, and chocolates, to brighten their day and create memorable moments. Upon arrival at the old age home at 10:30 am, we were greeted by the sister in charge with warm smiles and gratitude. The atmosphere was welcoming and serene. Our group of students were divided into smaller teams to engage

with different old residents. We began distributing the items we had brought with us. Fruits such as apples, bananas, and oranges, along with biscuits, bread, juice, and chocolates, were shared with the elderly residents. Their faces lit up with happiness as they received these treats. We organized interactive sessions that included conversations, storytelling, and singing.

These sessions allowed the residents to share their life experiences, while we, in turn, shared our thoughts and dreams with them. To add a fun element to the visit, we played games like bingo and cards with the elderly residents. Some students also showcased their talents by singing songs and performing short dances, which brought smiles and laughter to the room. To make the visit more personal, we handed out handmade cards and small gifts to the residents. These gestures were greatly appreciated, and the elderly residents cherished them. The whole event was a success under the coordination of Miss. Purnima, Mr. Ashutosha, Miss. Mansi, Mr. Pravas, Mr. Atal, and Mr. Barun, and was conceptualized by Dr. Jyotirmaya Sahoo.
