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

Objective: to make the students at ease with the campus, staffs, peers; to make the new entrants known to the rules & regulation of the University and to make them aware of the new curriculum and other aspects of academics.

About the Event: As a tradition, we at Arka Jain University conducted the orientation program to familiarize the students with the campus and prepare them up before the commencement of the regular classes. This year it was of offline mode other than the Yoga session. With the efforts of a wonderful team of organizers, administration and the able support of the management, we successfully organized an engaging and participative Orientation Program.

On the inaugural day, at Fasy Auditorium, Loyola School, Jamshedpur, all the new entrants of the University were invited along with their parents for a general induction event in which the Chief-Guest Mr. P. Reddy said that AJU is the most promising university in Eastern India and it will lead its students to greater heights and ensure all-round development through academics and co-curricular activities. Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor, Director, Mr. Amit Kumar Srivastav, and Registrar, Mr. Jasbir Singh Dhanjal also addressed the students. There were cultural events performed by the existing students of the University.

On the second day and the first day at the University campus, the guest Mr. Sarat Chandra said that the students must concentrate on their studies and head towards their goal. Prof. (Dr.) S. S. Razi, the VC said that the University would take all possible steps to provide requisite ambience to the students so that they study well and grow as good citizens. The respective PCs, Ms. Rajkumari Ghosh (English), Dr. Rahul Amin (JMC), Ms. Usha Kiran Barla (FD) and Dr. Santosh Kumar Singh (Biotechnology) briefed about their departments and introduced the respective faculty members.

The Glimpses of AJU were shared through power point presentations and the campus tour was also made possible by the concerned faculty members. Talent Hunt program was also announced and the new entrants were given the ID cards and transport ids. The session was declared to be ended after the National Anthem. The day's session was conducted by Ms. Usha Kiran Barla, PC, and Dept. of FD.



On the third day an online Yoga session was conducted by a Yoga expert of Jamshedpur in which she delivered some Yogic tips to the students and made them practice for an hour. The Director-Campus cum DSW, Dr. Angad Tiwary addressed the students in the campus. He said that students should take all possible interest to learn as much as possible during their stay in the campus as that would make their career bright.

There were sessions related to code of conduct, grievance handling, Festivities and Activities at AJ, Departmental Introductions, Departmental Guests and Seniors se Charcha, Syllabus / IA, Mentor Mentee, and Academic Calendar. There was an Ice-Breaker session ISO to get the students introduced to each other. A motivational Video related to Swami Vivekananda was also screened before the closure of the day's program. The sessions of the day were anchored by Ms. Shahin Fatma, Dept. of English.

The fourth day started with a team building game in which the students were asked to make teams from different disciplines except their own branches to get familiar with all batch mates. 
