

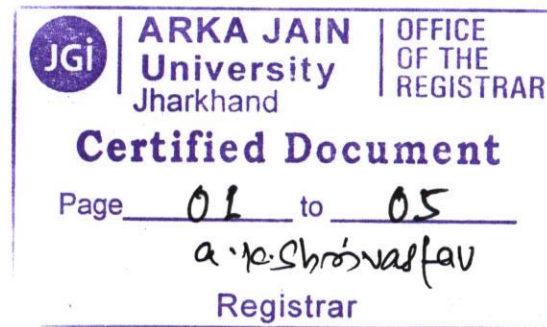

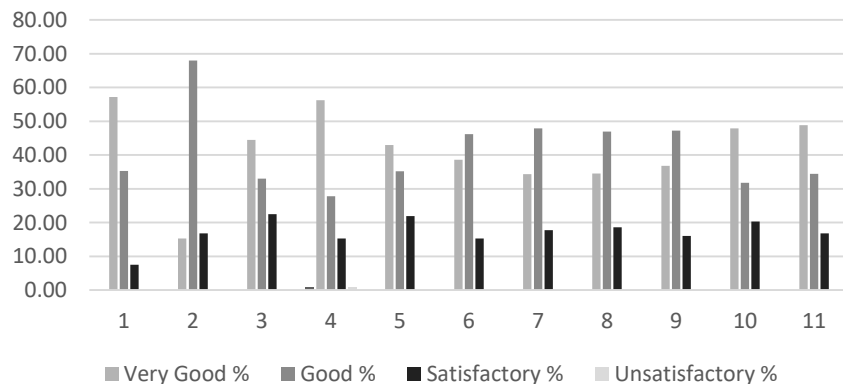

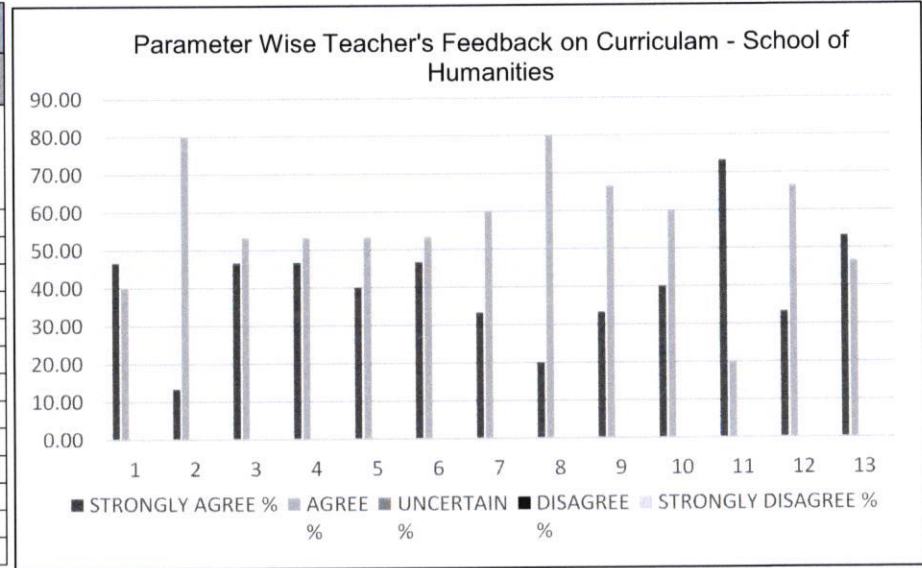
1	Course Content of the Syllabus
