OBJECTIVE: The significance of **"Kranti Ek Veer Katha"** lies in its portrayal of courage, sacrifice, and the struggle against injustice. The observance of a death anniversary holds importance as it remembers significant figures in the institution's history, fostering respect and unity. It imparts ethical values and historical awareness, inspiring students through role models.

DETAILS: "Bal Gangadhar Tilak", known as Lokmanya Tilak, was a prominent Indian nationalist and freedom fighter during the late 19th and early 20th centuries. He played a crucial role in India's fight against British colonial rule. Born on July 23, 1856, in Maharashtra, India, he passed away on August 1st, 1920. Tilak was dedicated to India's freedom and rallied the masses against British imperialism. He championed "Swaraj" (self-governance) and used newspapers like "Kesari" to spread nationalist ideals and empower Indians. He emphasized cultural identity, popularizing festivals for unity. Critical of "divide and rule", Tilak advocated for Hindu-Muslim harmony. He prioritized education, founding institutions like Fergusson College, and stood for direct action, famously stating, "Swaraj is my birthright and I shall have it". Tilak's leadership in the Indian National Congress shaped the freedom movement. Despite controversy and arrests for his views, he remains a symbol of courage, unity, and empowerment. His legacy inspires generations highly thinking of justice, equality, and national pride.

With deep reverence for the notable leader of India, the School of Pharmacy commemorated the occasion on August 5th, 2023, through **"KRANTI EK VEER**




Figure 1: Poster of the event "Kranti Ek Veer Katha"




Figure 7: A solemn instance to honour the memory of the Late Bal Gangadhar Tilak















