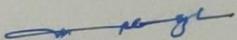

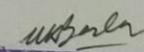
Dear Students,

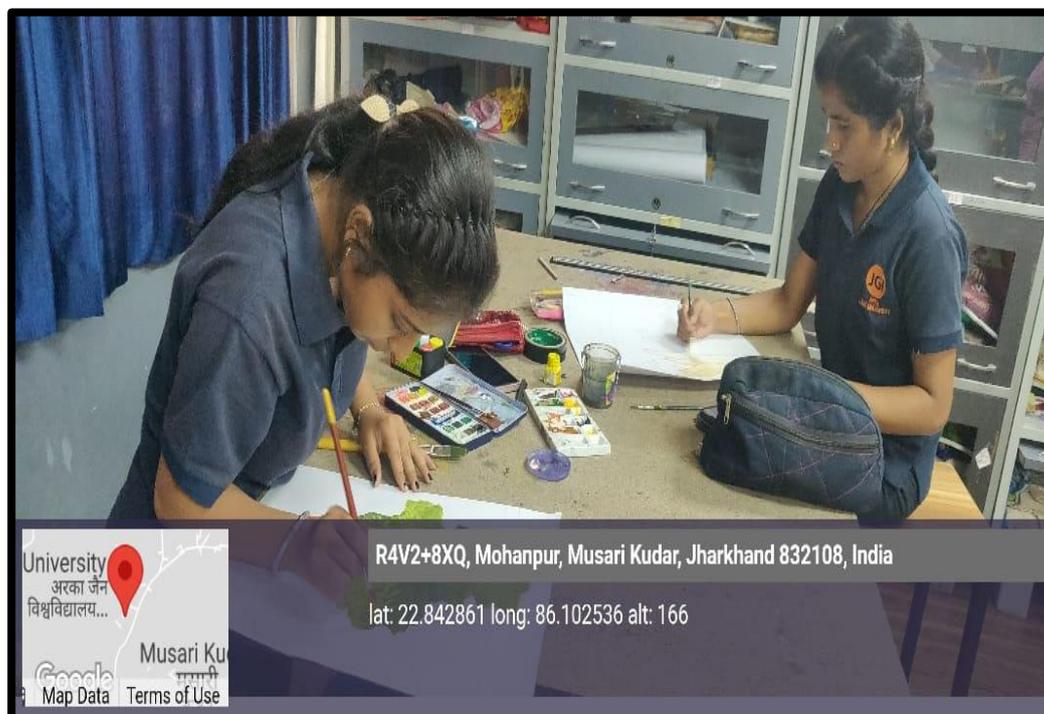


Figure 4: Patriotism pictures was imprinted on the canvas
