

OBJECTIVE:

Orientation is an important aspect of every new batch that enters into the college life. As per UGC, all bachelor’s degree programs must conduct a week long orientation program for inculcating important soft skills in the new students and to get to know one another.

ABOUT THE EVENT:

The event was held for 6 days where different activities, different guests (in house and outside), speeches and a tour to local museum were held.

Day 1:- Day 1 started with dissemination of lots of information about the University to the new batch of 2023. The Vision and Mission of the University and learning objectives of the Bachelor in Optometry Program. The students interacted with one another on the 1st day of the University. The Chief Guest for the day was Ms Mokshita Gautam, Entrepreneur & Faculty of Art of Living; who emphasized on mental well being and trying to live in stress free conditions. A session on Anti Ragging was taken by Mr Sarbojeet Goswami, the program coordinator of Optometry department and later on, a slogan writing competition was held. The session was concluded after singing the national anthem and students were sent to receive their University and Transport IDs.

Day 2:- An academic and fun approach was used for 2nd day. Students let off the steam with fun activities like dumb charades, ice breaking session and group dancing. A separate session on the code of conduct was held. The program

Day 3:- For Induction & Orientation of Optometry department, Day 3 consisted of various in house in-charge of different committees and cells, like Internal Complaints Committee, Grievance and Rotaract. 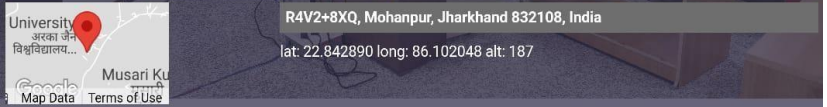


OBJECTIVE: The objective of conducting a code of conduct session in college is to provide a framework for ethical behaviour, ensure a harmonious and inclusive campus environment, and prepare students for their future roles as responsible and ethical members of society. It also contributes to a positive campus culture, fosters personal development, and prepares students for a future where ethical decision-making is a valuable asset.

DETAILS: The Code of Conduct session conducted as part of AARAMBH 2023 orientation cum induction program at the School of Pharmacy, Arka Jain University aimed to educate and engage students in discussions about ethical behaviour and maintaining a positive and respectful campus environment. The session was led by Miss Priyabati, Assistant Professor at the School of Pharmacy, Arka Jain University. 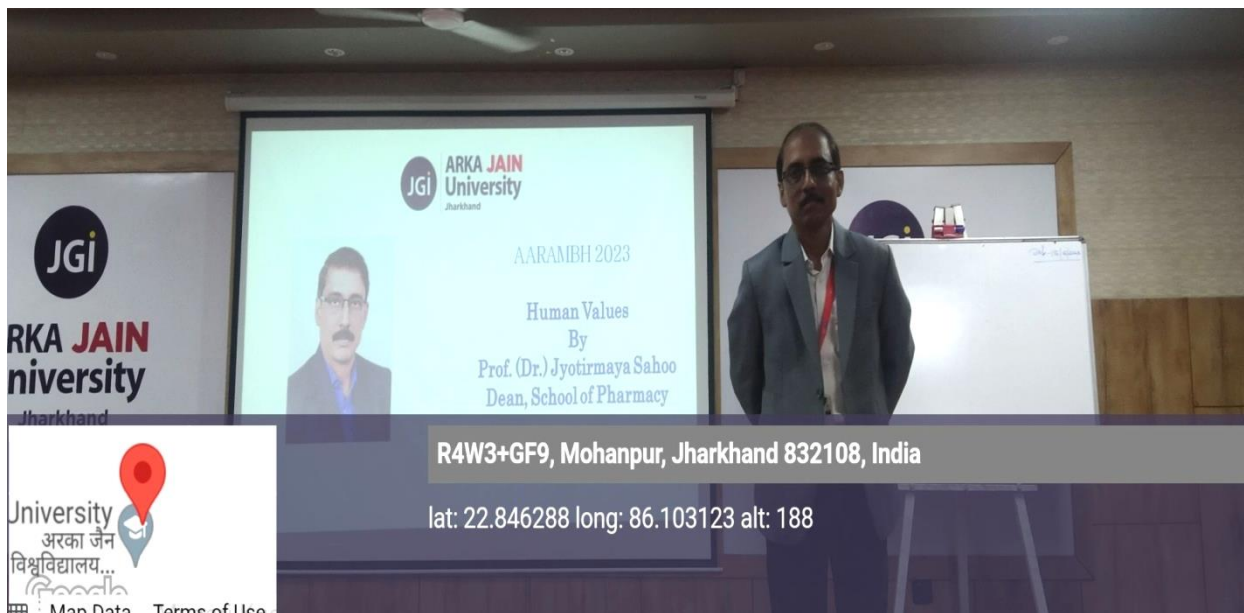
