

Orientation marks a successful beginning of a college session as it assures to the new students that they made a good decision in their college choice. It also helps students prepare for a successful career with clear vision about what lies ahead and what can be achieved at the end of their courses. Certain agendas were discussed, Share an orientation agenda in advance. Communicate orientation expectations and benefits. Create a welcoming and energetic atmosphere. Conduct icebreaker activities. Promote engagement in college traditions to build community. Provide relevant campus resources.

ABOUT THE EVENT:

The AARAMBH- INDUCTION PROGRAMM 2023, began from 21st -26th August 2023. The Orientation programme is an opportunity to introduce the new students to life at the Institute and facilitate a smooth transition the new life. The programme started with the welcome by the moderator of the day, Ms Shaheen Fatma, Assistant Professor (Dept. of English) to the dignitaries and other special guest. The day began with the inauguration of the event with the lamp lighting ceremony by the Honourable Chairman Board of Management of the university, the Chief Guest (Former MD, JAMIPOL) accompanied by the Dept. Heads of English and Biotechnology and the other faculties of the respective departments. The Mission and Vision was presented by Dr Santosh Kumar (Head, Dept of Biotechnology) and the Eminent Pillars of the university was presented by Ms Rajkumari Ghosh (Head, Dept. of English). The Chief Guest, gave his valuable input in the intellectual as well academic growth of the students. He even gave his thoughts on the ethical and moral duties of such young minds. There was a welcome dance performed by student and was followed by the presentation of Schedule of the

Orientation Programm and the revealing the Talent Hunt. The event concluded with the vote of thanks addressed by Dr Rupa Sarkar and with the National Anthem.

The Orientation programme is an opportunity to introduce the new students to life at the Institute and facilitate a smooth transition the new life. The Day 2 Induction program began with the welcoming of the audiences by the moderator, Dr Jyoti Khurana. The event began with Yoga / Meditation Session by Punam Verma ,Yoga and Reiki Master Yoga & Fitness Center, Jamshedpur. The session, through various asanas (poses), students improve flexibility, balance, coordination, and overall physical fitness. Regular yoga practice promotes a healthy lifestyle and fosters a positive body image. Boosting Emotional Well-being:Yoga promotes emotional balance by encouraging self-awareness and self-acceptance. The next session was on the Examination by Dr. Praveen Kumar Thakur Controller of Examination, Arka Jain University, and Jharkhand. Students were well guided on the procedures of university examinations.

Presentations were given on festivals and activities, also a talk on human values and presentation on motivation through video were shared with the students.

A talk on career guidance was given by Mr. Himanshu Kumar Sinha, Head Training & Placement, Arka Jain University, and Jharkhand. Letting students to know how and when to start their career planning.

The students were made to understand about life and stress through a Workshop on Suicide Prevention and Stress Management by Ms. Priya Ranjan, Sustainability Consultant And Trainer, Holistic Wellness Coach.

A special time was given to the new comers to know each other through the Ice Breaker Session / Know Each Other. The Day 2, Induction Programm ended with the National Anthem.

The Day-3 was coordinated and anchored by Dr. Manoj Kumar Pathak. In his introductory note he described the aim and objective of the induction program and suggested the attendees to be regular and attentive in all the session and take active participation in the participatory activities.

Dr. Jyoti Khurana presented a detailed report of the Festivals an Activities of AJU in which she made the students abreast of the cultural ethos of the university campus.

The IT rules and regulations, ERP Learning Management System was briefed by Mr. Sanjay Kumar Thakur, the ERP coordinator.

There was a movie, '1 Idiot' screened for them and a questionnaire based on it was served to them as an assignment.

Dr. Rupa Sarkar talked about the Student Support System available in the campus for the academic, administrative and holistic support to the students. She described the various services provided to the students by the University.

Dr. Manoj K Pathak, the NSS Program Officer, talked about the NSS and its objectives along with the activities it does in terms of community service. Dr. Pathak informed the new students that the minimum devotion towards NSS to obtain the NSS Certificate is 240 hrs in 2 years, and everyone should know the NSS song. He

said that NSS is about spreading awareness regarding the rights of a consumer, AIDS, Education, Clean Environment, so on. There was a

briefing session about the NIC (National Integration Camp). He presented through power point presentation the history of NSS, how it started, and the work done by the volunteers.

The objective of this was to emphasize how the students can extend their service for the development of the community. He further briefed about NCC and its achievements, duties and advantages.

Ms. Shahin Fatma gave inputs related to anti-ragging and punishments of ragging to prevent any physical or mental torture or any disorderly conduct towards any student causing apprehension, dread, humiliation, or agitation in him or her. It was also to maintain AJU – a ragging free campus and to create awareness about ragging & ensure a student-friendly environment at all times. It was ensued that the campus was no-ragging campus and the anti-ragging committee was made known to them along with the important phone numbers made available to them. There was a skit based on anti-ragging performed by the senior students of English department.

A session on Gender Sensitization was taken by Dr. Patima Srivastava who said that Gender sensitization is the process of creating awareness regarding gender equality issues and modifying the behaviour and views that people hold about themselves and other genders. Dr. Srivasatav said that gender sensitization can be achieved through various means, including education, training, and awareness-raising campaigns. She told that AJU has integrated it into university curricula, workplace policies, and community programs.

The Day was moderated by Dr. Pratima Srivastava Assistant Professor in Department of Biotechnology AJU. The program started by welcoming the students. The first guest speaker was Dr. Pompi Das Sengupta Associate Professor and Assistant Dean School of Commerce and Management AJU. Dr. Pompi explained the students about the importance of ICC Internal Complain Committee in the university. She informed the students that how they can utilize the facilities provided by ICC/Women's Cell in time of need. The system and process of functioning of the ICC committee was also delivered to the students. Next session at 8:40 AM was an expert talk by Mrs. Rajkumari Ghosh (Assistant Professor and Program Coordinator Department of English, School of Humanities AJU) about the various Clubs at AJU and regarding the online portals of learning for the students. She informed that students can join online courses on Linkedin which help them to upgrade their knowledge and resume.

In the next session Mrs. Shahin Fatma Assistant Professor, Department of English informed the students about Toast Masters Club. It was a participative session in which were given a table topic and they had speak for 2 minutes. Students actively took part in the event and also learned the process of functioning of a Toast Masters Meeting. Dr. Santosh Kumar Singh H.O.D Department of Biotechnology gave an expert talk on CII. He also explained the students about the students that they can

also be a member of CII. AJU and CII organize various student centric activities for the students of Arka Jain University. The next was the screening of a movie the "Idiot Returns" at 9:20 AM for all the students. Everyone enjoyed the movie and had a new take home lesson. Students were told to write a review about the screened movie as an assignment. Talent hunt was the next event, students participated with full enthusiasm. The winners were felicitated by Rajkumari Ghosh Ma'am.

Under the orientation plan for Batch 2023, BA English (H), AARAMBH- INDUCTION PROGRAMM 2023, a visit to Tribal Cultural Centre & Tata Zoological Park was planned. This was taken charge by the event co-ordinator, Dr Rupa Sarkar, Associate Professor, Dept. of English. The visit was to bring an understanding of the students for the cultural heritage of their state, Jharkhand. The Tribal Culture Centre is a popular tourist attraction in Jamshedpur which preserves the rich culture of the Santhal, Ho, Oraon, Munda and other tribes. The centre has huge sculptures of leaders of the freedom movement like Baba Tilka Majhi, Birsa Munda and Sidho-Kanhu. The gallery is lined with paintings and the inner repository has a variety of antiques and relics on display.

The visit to the zoo fulfilled two such purposes, knowing the environment as well a fun outing with the fellow batch mates. Even the Only privately operated zoo in India by a Corporate house. Major attraction being Mandrill, African Lions, white tiger, Zebra and butterfly park. 





ABOUT THE EVENT:






Figure 2:- The program coordinator awarding the students for winning 1st prize in poster making competition.




Figure 3:- The students taking part in the slogan & poster making competition for Anti Ragging Week.

Day 6:-




TAKEAWAY (OUTCOME):






Figure 1: Ms Shreya Chakraborty, faculty of Department of Optometry addressing the gathering about Code of Conduct and guidelines of the University.

The following outcomes of the events:-






Figure 1:Ms Nikita Michelle, faculty of BA Fashion Design, addressed the new batch of students with a presentation on General stereotypes faced by each gender




Figure 2: Dr. CharuWadhwa,the Head of the Internal Complaints Committee and Women's Cell educating the students about making the university a safer place for each gender.


TAKEAWAY (OUTCOME):








Figure 1: Local Tour to Tribal Culture Centre at Sonari, Jamshedpur on the 5th day of Orientation






Figure 2: Some stills from the Tribal Cultural Centre




Figure 11: Alumni interacting with new students during Alumni Talk session


