**OBJECTIVE:** For enacting a scene by the student from the taught lesson to test the understanding as well as for good revision simultaneously to inspire those students who have less interest on the subject.

**DETAILS:** In Indian classrooms, a diverse range of students coexist, including advanced learners who excel, average learners who often rely on teachers, and slower learners who require extra support both in and out of class. Regardless of whether a student falls on the slower or advanced end of the spectrum, it remains crucial for the teacher to be an unbiased role model for the academic progress of all students. To make this action effective the faculty needs to develop as well as adapt different teaching methodologies to make the class interesting. Role play classes benefit both slow and advanced learners. Slow learners engage better with concepts, improving understanding and confidence. Advanced learners deepen their understanding, enhancing critical thinking and communication skills. Role play accommodates diverse learning levels, making education more inclusive and effective. Keeping this situation in view and for the development of students of both categories. School of Pharmacy conducted a session "A Role Play on Dosage Form" on 17th August, 2023. This session was designed to captivate the attention of both slowe and advanced learners, providing them with a concise overview of dosage forms along with their merit, demerits, route of administration and how to prepare the different dosage form. Given that dosage preparation bears immense significance in the trajectory of a pharmaceutical graduate, attaining comprehensive knowledge in this domain is pivotal during a student's academic journey. The students of B.PHARM (2<sup>nd</sup> Sem) were guided to play the different role on DOSAGE FORM as per their choice. Various Dosage forms like Antidote, Liniment, ODT Tablet, Injection, Antibiotic Tablet, Elixir, and Ointment were enacted by the students .The students eagerly participated and the session was quite interesting. The session was conceptualized by Dr. Jyotirmaya Sahoo, and coordinated by Mr. Asutosha Parida and Ms. Purnima Mahato.



**OUTCOMES**: The session aroused the interest of slow learners in a subject they had previously shown limited enthusiasm for, while advanced learners found it a valuable opportunity for revision. Engaging activities like these should be consistently organized to foster on-going student development.




Figure 2: Student's Insightful Presentation of Her Role




Figure 3: "The Power of Performance: Students Delivering Messages Through Theatrical Expression"


Figure 8: Student Bringing Her Role to Life with Enthusiastic Explanation




Figure 9: "Fostering Peer Understanding: Collaborative Student-Faculty Interaction in Session"
