DETAILS: Jharkhand foundation Day is celebrated every year on 15th November. Jharkhand was earlier a part of Bihar. Jharkhand was formed as a new state on November 15, 2000. At the time of formation. Jharkhand became the 28th state of the country. The separation occurred following a prolonged tribal movement advocating for statehood. November 15 holds a dual significance as it marks the birth anniversary of tribal leader Birsa Munda .Birsa played a crucial role in the tribal movement against the British in the 1870s.




Figure 1: Poster of the Jharkhand Foundation Day


