

OBJECTIVE:

Organizing skill development workshop serves various objectives, contributing to the personal and professional growth of individuals. Here are some key objectives:

Improving Skill: The workshops give participants the chance to improve their current abilities or learn new ones, so they may become more proficient in the sector of their choice. Students develop a workforce that has a variety of sophisticated skill sets, since this will enhance the general competence and efficacy of the organization.

Ability to Adjust: It gives people the tools they need to adjust to shifting industry trends and technology developments so they can stay productive and relevant in their jobs.

Filling up Skill Gaps: Workshops determine whether people in the organization lack the skills needed to fulfil the demands of their jobs now and in the future, and take steps to close such gaps.

Keeping the above mentioned objectives in mind, a work shop on dispensing optics was organized for the students of Optometry.

ABOUT THE EVENT:

‘Research Methodology Workshop’ was the title given to the two hours of workshop organized by the department of Optometry. The resource person was Dr Shweta, Assistant professor of Pharmacy Department. The two hours of the brainstorming session included, discussions on how to choose the articles from different search engines, finding relevant articles in the field of interest, compiling the data from the articles found, addressing the literature gap and finally formulating a Literature Review accordingly. The first and the third year students benefitted from the workshop, since they will have an opportunity to pursue the research aspects of Optometry in their further career; we had our resource person who has been into the research field for the many years.

The workshop involved learning and relearning of certain specific procedures and protocols used in academic research and retail and dispensing related optometry researches. Starting with, the common search engines used by researchers nowadays to find articles, followed by elaborating the steps to formulate a perfect literature review. Thirdly, a brief of the article selection based on the Title, Inclusion and Exclusion Criteria and the Body of the article was provided.

TAKEAWAY (OUTCOME):

Students had a great learning session with Dr Shweta, where they got a brief idea on how to perform a Literature Review properly. Moreover, they learned to perform a scrutiny on the research articles chosen on the basis of the Title of the study, Inclusion and the Exclusion criteria and exclude them if one of the any following ideas were not satisfied.

Conclusion: The following are some important lessons that people often learn during workshops:

Acquiring information: The purpose of workshops is to teach certain information or abilities. Individuals might acquire fresh perspectives, knowledge, and proficiency in a certain area of study or profession.

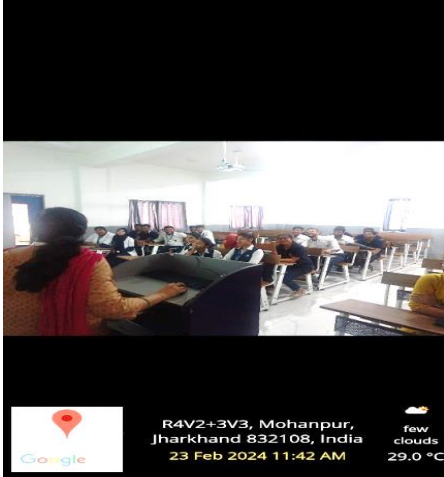

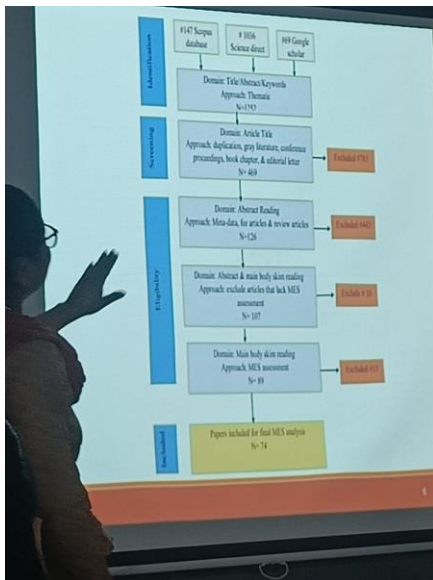
