

OBJECTIVE:

In a world where vision is often taken for granted, the importance of proactive eye care cannot be overstated. Recognizing this crucial aspect of overall health, [Jamshedpur Public School, Baridih] took a proactive step towards promoting eye wellness by hosting a Medical Eye Screening Camp on [26.04.2024] within its premises. This initiative aimed not only to detect potential eye ailments but also to raise awareness about the significance of regular eye check-ups among students, staff, and the broader community.

The event, organized in collaboration with NSS, witnessed a convergence of medical professionals, volunteers, and eager participants, all united by a common goal: to safeguard the precious gift of sight. Through a series of comprehensive eye examinations, participants had the opportunity to assess their ocular health under the expert guidance of optometrists.

ABOUT THE EVENT:

The day started with journey to Jamshedpur Public School, where our team reported at 6:50 AM. It took about 30 minutes for our team, to settle things up for the camp. The camp started with a short orientation speech delivered to the students by Mr. Suresh Laher, which included basic information about understanding the concept of optometry, how to choose a career in optometry after 10+2, what all things we all study during the course and the career

opportunities after completing the course. Moreover, the speech included points on why a person should choose optometry as his career instead of choosing other professions.

Following to that, the eye screening program was conducted where 233 participants were being assessed one by one. There was some battery of test employed to perform the screening, which included tests such as history taking, visual acuity assessment, torch light examination, Static retinoscopy and a subjective refraction. Subjective refraction result determined the refractive error status of the participant. All the participant medical details were encrypted into the outreach activity register of Arka Jain University, which was later brought back to the campus and further scrutinized. The camp ends at 12: 30 PM, the instruments were packed up and were carried back to the university.

TAKEAWAY (OUTCOME):

Our recent eye screening camp held at the school premises was a resounding success, underscoring the critical importance of early detection and intervention in children's eye health. We identified numerous students who were previously unaware of their vision needs, providing them, and their families, with the necessary guidance and referrals to ensure timely treatment. This initiative not only highlights the value of regular eye health checks in promoting optimal learning and development but also strengthens community awareness and support for ongoing health education. Together, we are taking important steps towards safeguarding the visual health of our future generations.

CONCLUSION:

In conclusion, the medical eye screening camp held at [Jamshedpur Public School, Baridih] was a resounding success, bringing together community members, healthcare professionals, and educators in a collaborative effort to promote ocular health among students. Through comprehensive screenings, valuable insights were gained into the eye health of our young learners, enabling early detection and intervention for various ocular conditions. In the outreach extension activity, 233 school students were screened, out of which 20 of the students had been observed to require refractive correction, they were prescribed with prescription. Moreover, it was also seen that 2 of the school students were diagnosed with nystagmus, 2 students with ocular misalignment and 1 student with amblyopia. These particular students were sent to the base hospital for further management of their condition. The event not only prioritized the well-being of students but also underscored the importance of proactive healthcare initiatives within

educational settings. Moving forward, we remain committed to fostering a culture of preventive care and ensuring that every child has access to essential eye health services. We extend our heartfelt gratitude to all volunteers, organizers, and participants whose dedication made this event possible. Together, we continue to envision a future where sight is not just a gift but a fundamental right for all.

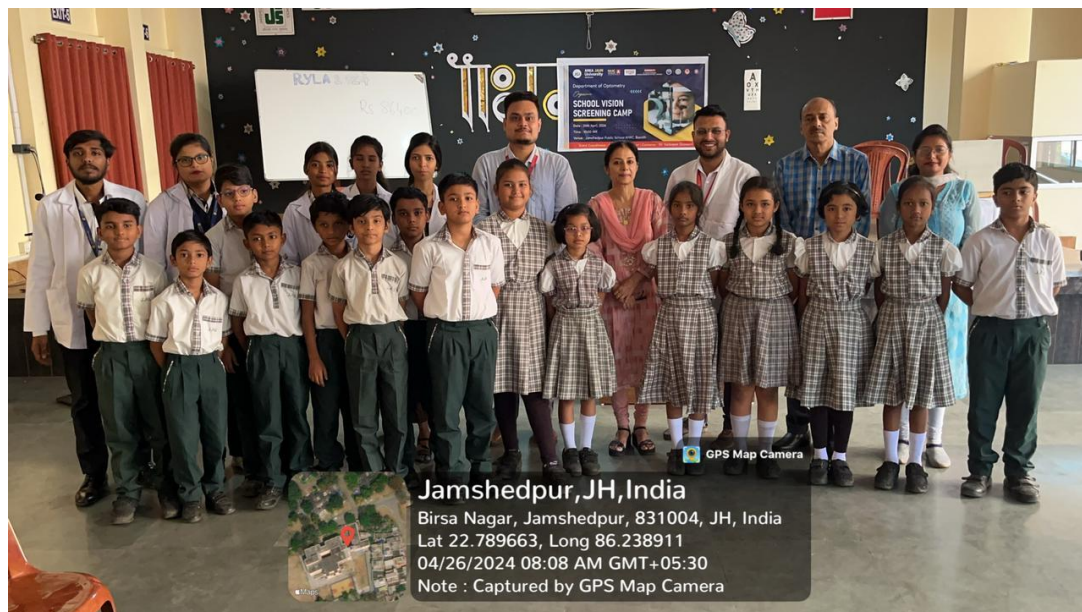

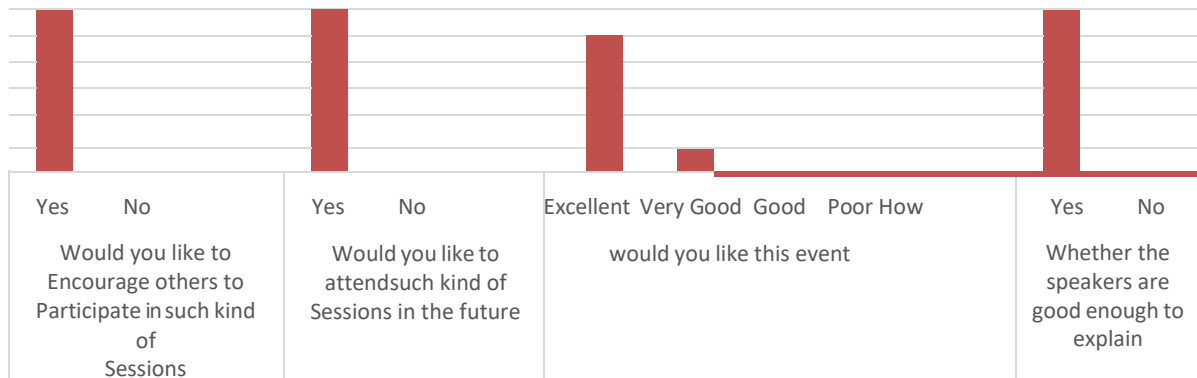
