# INFRASTRUCTURE







#### **B. Optometry**

Optometry is a health care profession that is autonomous and concerned especially with examining the eye for defects and faults of refraction, with prescribing correctional lenses, prisms, eye exercises and/or visual rehabilitation care for visually impaired, with diagnosing diseases of the eye, and with treating such diseases or referring (Specialty) them for treatment. Optometry as a profession has the primary public health responsibility for eliminating uncorrected refractive error (the leading cause of vision impairment globally). As primary eye care practitioner, optometrists have a vital role in detecting potentially serious eye diseases such as cataract, glaucoma and Diabetic retinopathy, age-related maculopathy, as well as general health conditions such as hypertension, diabetes, Thyroid etc. which means optometrists can also help to alleviate the burden of other causes of blindness and diseases through diagnosis & referral.

#### **B. Sc. Biotechnology**

ARKA JAIN University offers Bachelor of Science in Biotechnology course that designed to equip the students with all the tools and techniques both in theory and practical session of Modern Biology for application in Industry and Research fields. 


Fig 3.14 Professor (Dr.) Prabal K. Sen Former Professor, Economics Area & Chairperson, Entrepreneurship Development Centre (EDC) at XLRI Jamshedpur




Fig 4.6 Arrangement of Lunch for village kids

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




Fig 6.10 Mr Santosh Sharma addressing the gathering during Shikhar




Fig 6.11 Farewell Fashion show by the pass outs during Rukhsat
