















Student Grievance Redressal Cell

WRWY (We R with You), the Grievance Redressal Cell attempts to address genuine problems and complaints of students whatever be the nature of the problem. Students are encouraged to approach the members of the cell or any of their other teachers as is comfortable to them. Students are advised that to make a complaint is serious and therefore they are to use this power in a responsible manner. 




Fig. 2.2 MoU between AJU and IRIS






Fig 3.5 - Community Field Visit Awareness Programme




Fig 3.8 - Handwash Awareness campaign

AJU organizes Aagaaz as the annual cultural fest to rejuvenate the students and create an ethos of collective effort and cultural interaction.




Fig 4.1 - Annual Cultural Fest




Fig 4.8 - Yuva group photo




Fig 4.12- Lighting if Lamp during Roshni




Fig 6.1- Prizes & Trophies of Annual Sports Meet




TRAINING AND PLACEMENT & TOP RECURUITING AGENCIES




Fig 5.1 - Counselling Centre




Fig 6.4 AJU Indoor Sports centre




Fig 10.7 Leg press machine at $\operatorname{\mathsf{Gym}}$ Centre




