OBJECTIVE: To motivate the students to speak up for wrong and to encourage them to fight against ragging. To make students learn the technique of conducting and shooting talk shows on important topics.

DETAILS: Department of Journalism and Mass Communication of Arka Jain University organized a talk show titled 'Empowering Voices: The fight Against Ragging'.

This session was started by the moderator of the show Vishakha Pandey, Student final year, Department of Journalism and Mass Communication by welcoming all the four panelists S. Sneha, Rahul Deo Mahato, Final year students, Divyadarshini Singh and Seikh Manowar Ali, second year students and the audience, with an objective to be observant about the act of ragging and its repercussions, and to raise the voice against the ill-practice of ragging.

The students of the department interacted with the panelists and asked questions related to ragging, its prevention and the right channel to report it.

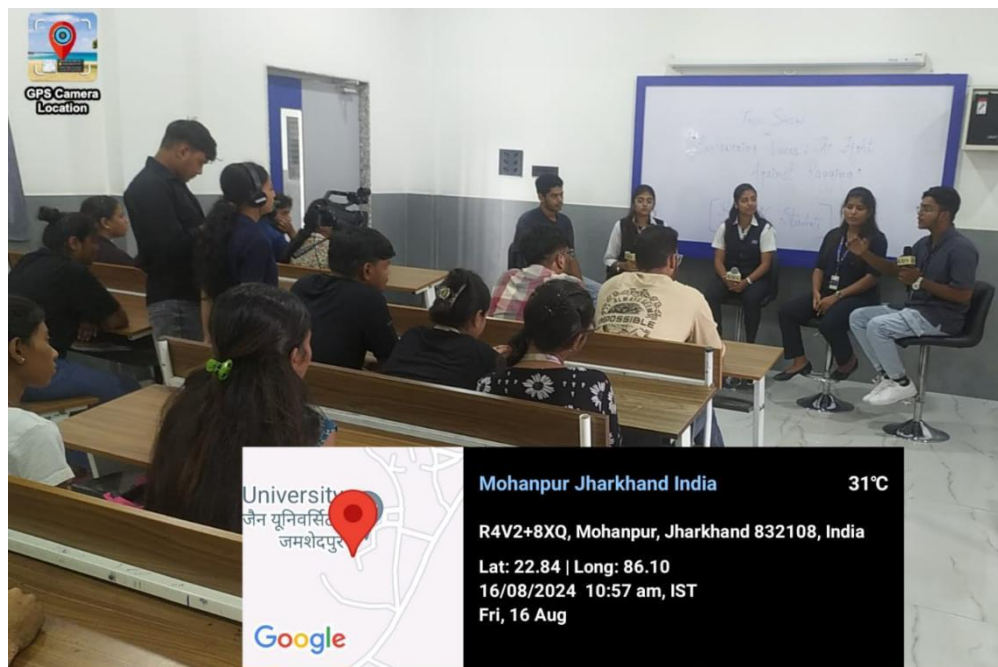


Figure 3: Seikh Manowar Ali, student, Batch 2023-26, addressing the question from the audience
