OBJECTIVE:

- 1. To provide students a platform to learn the basics of financial literacy.
- 2. To enable students in sharpening their financial acumen.

DETAILS:

Day-1

A financial literacy game "Check It Out" was organized through online mode for students. Students participated in large numbers and they enjoyed the game a lot. The intent of the game was to make the participants understand the importance of budgeting and balancing their income and expense position.

Day-2

A seminar was organized on "Inflation Scenario in India" where students presented their viewpoints on the effects of inflation in the country's economy. The topic was debated in detail and session outcome was fruitful.

Day-3

Final year students of the Department of Management (BBA) organized a virtual presentation session on Portfolio Management Services wherein they talked about financial instruments and investment rationality in detail. At the end of the session a Google Form questionnaire was circulated among the students to assess their level of financial awareness.





Day-4

Today, an online Investment Quiz was circulated to the students of BBA Semester-II and they were asked to attempt the same. The questionnaire comprised of questions on financial literacy, financial instruments, general awareness, etc. The test received overwhelming response from students.

Day-5

On the culminating day, a group discussion was organized amongst the first year students on the topic "Making India Cashless". The students were grouped on the basis of their sections and each of them brought out their viewpoints on the topic. Most of the students talked about the advantages of being cashless and a handful of them only put forward its drawbacks.

The event proved to be a successful one and students absorbed the session well. The event was moderated by Prof. Chanchal Mandal, Prof. Atul Pathak, Prof. Prince Jaiswal and Dr. Manoj Dash, Member of Faculty from the School of Commerce and Management and office bearers of the Finance Club at Arka Jain University.

OUTCOME:

- 1. Students got to know about their financial awareness level.
- 2. Students were able to learn new lessons and absorb new ideas on financial literacy and the economy as a whole.




Figure 3: Group photo of Seminar on Day 2
