OBJECTIVE: The objective of the medicinal garden or botanical garden visit is to create awareness of conservation and traditional uses of herbs and medicinal plants, and also to identify different rare plants that are studied in the syllabus.

DETAILS: Lalbagh Botanical Garden was commissioned in 1760 by Hyder Ali and expanded by his son, Tipu Sultan. The garden also features a Glass House, inspired by London's Crystal Palace, which hosts annual flower shows on Republic Day and Independence Day. It has a wide variety of plants, including

Exotic plants: From Persia, Afghanistan, and France, including cacti, succulents, and flowering plants like orchids and roses

Native plants: A diverse collection of native and exotic plants from around the world

Tropical plants: A special collection of tropical plants

Alpine plants: A special collection of alpine plants

Bonsai trees: Meticulously pruned miniature trees in the Bonsai Garden

Rose garden: A colorful display of roses in full bloom

Wichita blue: A popular juniper variety with vibrant blue foliage and a pyramidal shape

Three mango trees: Located near the fernery, these trees are said to be over 250 years old. 85 students from School of Pharmacy visited this botanical garden under the guidance of 8 faculty members on 21st October 2024. They understood the different pharmacognostical importance of different plants.
