All are suggested to take active participation in the same to celebrate the spirit of our Constitution and reaffirm our commitment to its values.



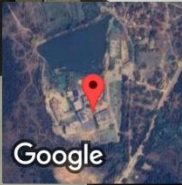

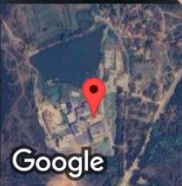
