INTER- SCHOOL DEBATE COMPETITION ON “REPUBLIC DAY AND PARAKRAM DIVAS

Objective: The Inter-School Debate Competition was organized by the School of Law, ARKA JAIN University, Jharkhand, on 23rd January 2025, to commemorate two significant national events—Parakram Diwas and Republic Day. Parakram Diwas, observed on 23rd January, marks the birth anniversary of Netaji Subhas Chandra Bose, one of India’s most prominent freedom fighters, while Republic Day, on 26th January, commemorates the adoption of the Indian Constitution in 1950, making India a sovereign democratic republic. The competition aimed to provide a platform for students to engage in intellectually stimulating discussions, develop critical thinking skills, and express their views on topics related to the importance of these historic occasions.

Details: The competition saw enthusiastic participation from students of the Law department (BBA LL.B.) along with students from various other departments of the university. Participants engaged in spirited discussions on themes celebrating the significance of Republic Day and Parakram Diwas. Through well-researched arguments, they showcased their knowledge of history, governance, and patriotism, fostering a deep sense of respect and pride for these monumental days. The event not only highlighted students’ debating abilities but also enhanced their understanding of constitutional values and national heritage.

The debate competition was conducted at the Moot Court Room, Nagarjuna-E Block, 4th Floor, ARKA JAIN University, starting at 11:00 AM. The event consisted of three rounds—Preliminary, Semi-Final, and Final—designed to assess participants' abilities across various judging criteria. The rubrics for evaluation included Content & Argumentation (10 marks), Delivery & Presentation (8 marks), Rebuttal & Counterarguments (6 marks), Time Management (4 marks), and Overall Impact (2 marks), making a total of 30 marks per participant in each round. Participants were evaluated on their clarity of arguments, relevance to the topic, depth of research, articulation, confidence, counterarguments, and adherence to time limits. The highest-scoring participants advanced through the rounds until the final stage of the competition.

The event was graced by distinguished guests and faculty members who played an integral role in its success. Prof. (Dr.) Praveen Kumar Thakur presided over the event as the Chief Guest, while Dr. Pompidas Sengupta, Assistant Dean, Department of School of Commerce and Management, also honored the occasion. The judging panel comprised Dr. Rupa Sarkar, Associate Professor, Department of English, and Mr. Ujwal Prakash, Assistant Professor,

School of Commerce and Management. Additionally, the event was coordinated under the guidance of respected faculty members, including Dr. Archita Das, Programme Coordinator, along with Event Coordinators Sandip Chanda, Dr. Koyel Roy, and several other esteemed professors from various departments who provided motivation and support to the participants.

Outcomes: The Inter-School Debate Competition successfully met its objectives and had a lasting impact on all attendees. Students gained a deeper awareness of the Constitution's relevance in contemporary India, recognizing it as a living document that adapts to societal changes. The event provided a valuable opportunity for participants to refine their public speaking, critical thinking, and debating skills, preparing them for future professional challenges. Furthermore, the competition instilled a strong sense of patriotism and responsibility among students, encouraging them to uphold constitutional values. The event also fostered collaboration and networking among students, faculty, and judges, creating an atmosphere of mutual respect and intellectual exchange. 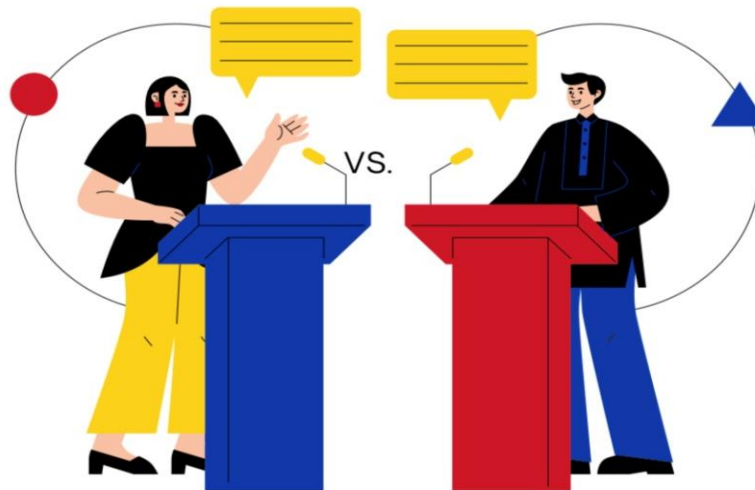

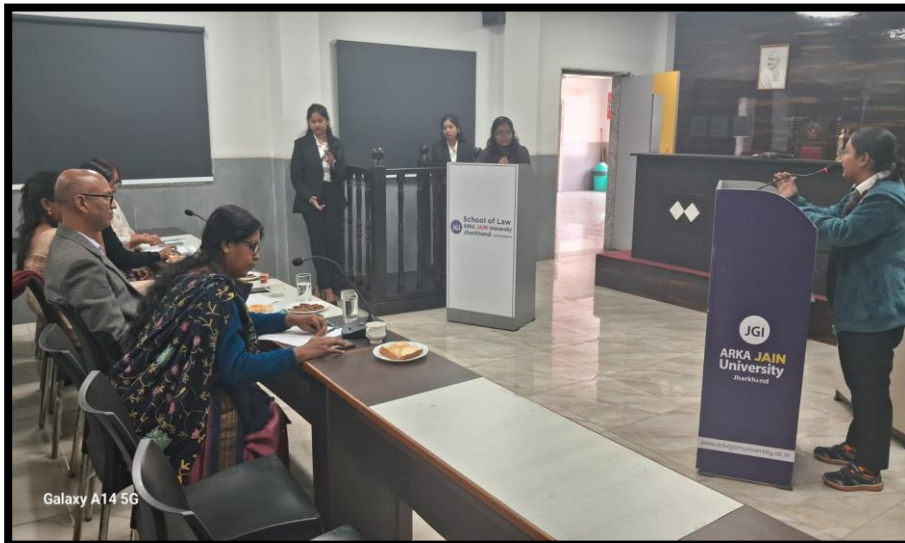


FIG 3: Participants contested at INTER-SCHOOL DEBATE COMPETITION


