



Objective: The objective of this event was to make students aware of Intellectual Property Rights (IPR) and its subject matter. This session aimed to educate students on various areas of IPR, emphasizing its significance in today's world driven by innovation in science, technology, and art. The session also highlighted the role of IPR in protecting creative works, encouraging innovation, and fostering economic growth.

Brief of the Event: The IPR session was conducted to address the growing importance of Intellectual Property Rights due to advancements in various fields. 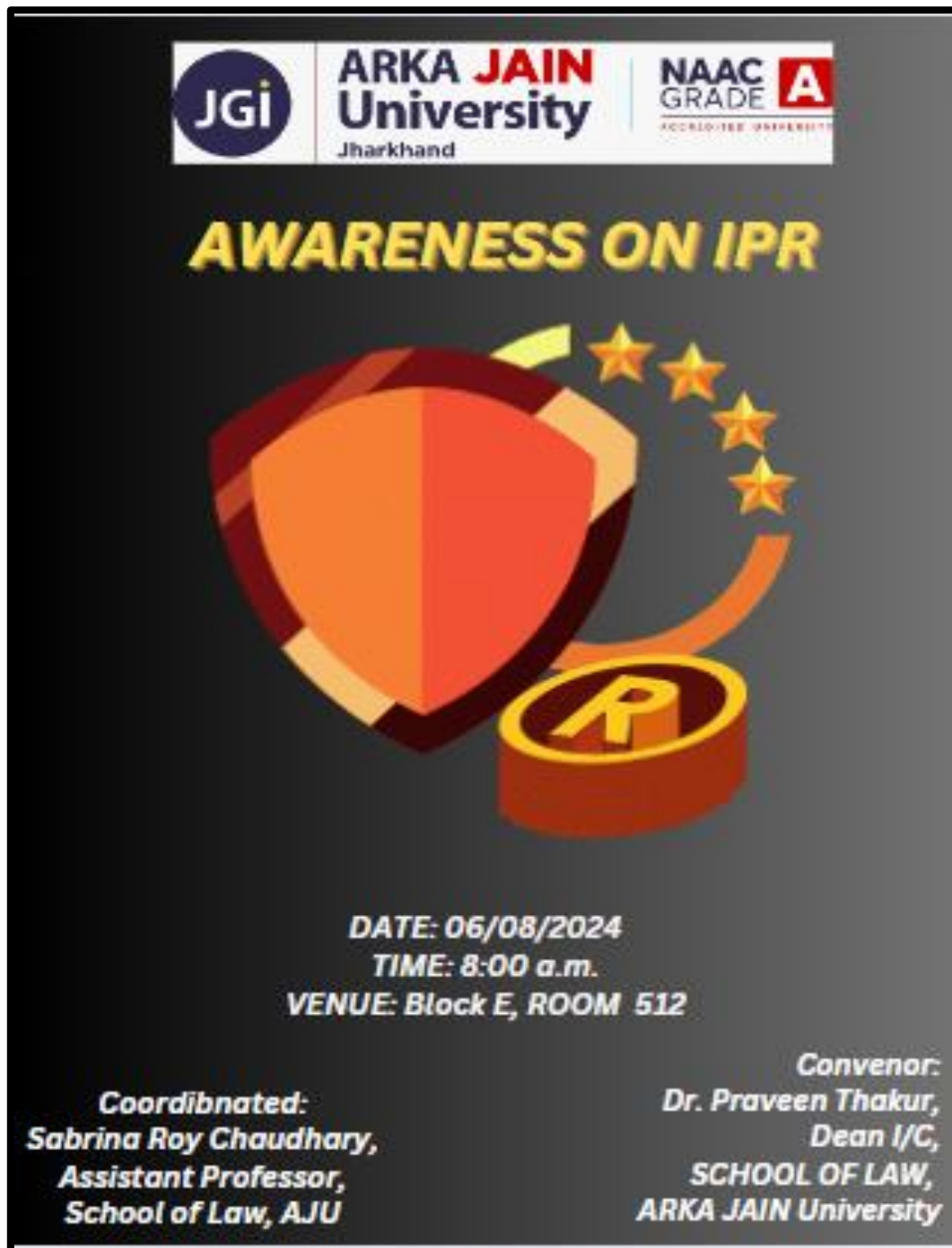
