OBJECTIVE: To educate students about myopia, highlighting its causes, symptoms, and the importance of early detection and prevention. The session provided comprehensive information on risk factors, such as genetic predisposition and lifestyle habits, and offered practical advice on preventive measures, including encouraging outdoor activities, proper lighting, and regular eye check-ups. By raising awareness and promoting proactive eye care, the session sought to empower students to take charge of their eye health, thereby fostering a culture of health consciousness and prevention among the young attendees.

DETAILS: On October 30, 2024, the Department of Optometry, School of Health and Allied Science in association with Ikshana Club and NSS, Arka Jain University with collaboration of MoU partner, ASG Eye Hospital, Sakchi organized a comprehensive Myopia Awareness Session and School Children Eye Camp at Atomic Energy Central School, Jaduguda, aimed at educating students about myopia, its causes, prevention, and management. The program began with a welcome address from the school principal, followed by detailed presentations by the Prof. Pranab Das and other members of Ikshana Club on the definition, symptoms, and risk factors of myopia, including genetic predisposition and lifestyle habits. Practical tips on preventing myopia, such as encouraging outdoor activities, taking regular breaks from near-work tasks, and ensuring proper lighting while studying, were shared. An interactive Q&A session allowed students to engage and ask questions about eye health. The session also featured an eye screening camp, where students received on-site eye check-ups and immediate feedback.







The eye screening camp identified students needing further examination, providing immediate benefits through on-site eye check-ups. The session ensured the knowledge was shared with families, reinforcing the importance of eye health at home. The high engagement level during the Q&A session and positive feedback from attendees underscored the session's success in promoting proactive eye care and health consciousness.
