The National Eye Donation Fortnight is an initiative taken by the Government of India, Ministry of Health and Family Welfare and National Program for Control of Blindness and Vision Impairment. The fortnight is observed from 25th August to 8th September every year, this year it was the 39th fortnight. To commemorate the same, the Department of Optometry at ARKA JAIN University organized a National Eye Donation Awareness -Poster Competition on 11th September 2024. The event aimed to raise awareness about the importance of eye donation and to encourage students to participate actively in promoting this noble cause through creative and educational posters. The competition was conducted under the supervision of Ms. Bhavana Kumari, a faculty member of the Department of Optometry, School of Health and Allied Science. It was an engaging event designed to foster creativity while spreading awareness about the vital need for eye donation, particularly in addressing corneal blindness.

OBJECTIVE:

The event sought to educate students about the significance of eye donation and its life changing impact on individuals suffering from blindness. ABOUT THE EVENT:

The National Eye Donation Awareness - Poster Competition, held on 11th September 2024, was organized by the Department of Optometry at ARKA JAIN University as part of a broader effort to raise awareness about eye donation. The event was conducted by Ms.




Fig 1: Poster of the event


