OBJECTIVE: In observance of Constitution Day, celebrated on November 26th every year, to honor the adoption of the Constitution of India. Constitution Day commemorates the day when the Indian Constitution was adopted in 1949 and came into effect on January 26, 1950. This significant day is observed to promote awareness about the Constitution and its importance in the governance and democracy of India.

DETAILS: On 26th November 2024, the Department of Optometry, School of Health and Allied Science, Arka Jain University observed the constitution day under the theme "Unity in Diversity" organized a Painting/ Poster Making Competition. The event aimed to honor the adoption of the Constitution of India. The competition aimed to highlight the core constitutional value of unity in diversity, which is a foundational principle of India's national identity.


