OBJECTIVES: To develop a deeper understanding of the complexities involved in providing care to patients undergoing haemodialysis.

DETAILS: On **25**th **October 2024**, the **School of Nursing, ARKA JAIN University**, organized an observational visit for 02nd Year GNM Nursing Students to the **ENDOSCOPY ROOM & RADIOLOGY DEPARTMENT** at **MGM Hospital & Medical College, Jamshedpur**. This visit was an integral part of the curriculum which will help the students in providing with hands-on learning in clinical settings, allowing them to observe advanced diagnostic procedures and deepen their understanding of patient care techniques in specialized units.

The practical integration of theory and practice was strengthened through observational visits in the people or groups of healthcare in practice. This was enhanced by allowing students to see, comprehend, and witness how their future co-workers go about their daily work duties in various units. Hence, studying the procedure and interaction as well as experience in endoscopy, radiology, and operating theatre facilities expands the knowledge base of students regarding the patient care continuum.

It was learned how gastrointestinal nursing care involved specialized procedures that could be observed first-hand in the endoscopy room. It was possible to understand the sequence of assessment, preparation, and care due to witnessing the procedure of endoscopic examinations. In particular, several infection control procedures and application of technology during endoscopy were noted during the tour. Endoscopy takes a team and communication is vital especially during stressful procedures and this experience reinforced the essence of primary health care. There were nursing implications that emerged during the coursework that focused on the role of nursing towards optimal patient care outcomes in gastroenterology and these were comprehensively addressed durina the breadth of the course. The 02nd Year GNM Nursing Students had the chance to witness and comprehend some diagnostic imaging techniques during their rotation in the Radiology Department, namely X-rays, CT-scan and MRI. They understood how the patient must observe both positioning and safety measures and what a fundamental task radiologic technologists have in the production of diagnostic images. Furthermore, the students appreciated the





work of radiologists in relation to the diagnosis and the description of the images which completed their views of the diagnostic process. To sum up, the field's trip enabled students appreciate the multidisciplinary approach to patient management values in the psychiatric ward and further enhanced their clinical experience and development goals. Students were shown the different areas of the OT and the procedures they would see. The main aim of the visit was for students to see the workflow and patient care in the OT and for students to meet the OT staff and understand the interdisciplinary nature of patient care. By the end of the visit students should have an understanding of pre-op, intra-op and post-op patient care in the OT.




