### **Eligibility for Ph.D Programme**

The admission to the Ph.D. programme would strictly be done on the basis of UGC (Minimum Standards and Procedures for Award of 'Ph.D Degree) Regulations, 2022. An applicant possessing any of the following qualifications shall be eligible to apply for admission to a Ph.D. Programme of the University:

- i. A 1-year/2-semester master's degree programme after a 4-year/8-semester bachelor's degree programme or a 2-year/4-semester master's degree programme after a 3-year bachelor's degree programme or qualifications declared equivalent to the master's degree by the corresponding statutory regulatory body, with at least 55% marks in aggregate or its equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed or equivalent qualification from a foreign educational institution accredited by an assessment and accreditation agency which is approved, recognized or authorized by an authority, established or incorporated under a law in its home country or any other statutory authority in that country to assess, accredit or assure quality and standards of the educational institution.  
A relaxation of 5% marks or its equivalent grade may be allowed for those belonging to SC/ST/OBC (non-creamy layer)/Differently-Abled, Economically Weaker Section (EWS) and other categories of candidates as per the decision of the Commission from time to time. Provided that a candidate seeking admission after a 4-year/8-semester bachelor's degree programme should have a minimum of 75% marks in aggregate or its equivalent grade on a point scale wherever the grading system is followed. A relaxation of 5% marks or its equivalent grade may be allowed for those belonging to SC/ST/OBC (non-creamy layer)/Differently-Abled, Economically Weaker Section (EWS) and other categories of candidates as per the decision of the commission from time to time.
- ii. Candidates who have completed the M.Phil. programme with at least 55% marks in aggregate or its equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed or equivalent qualification from a foreign educational institution accredited by an assessment



and accreditation agency which is approved, recognized or authorized by an authority, established or incorporated under a law in its home country or any other statutory authority in that country to assess, accredit or assure quality and standards of educational institutions, shall be eligible for admission to the Ph.D Programme. A relaxation of 5% marks or its equivalent grade may be allowed for those belonging to SC/ST/OBC (non-creamy layer)/Differently-Abled, Economically Weaker Section (EWS) and other categories of candidates as per the decision of the Commission from time to time.

- iii. Professional qualification in Chartered Accountancy/ Cost Accountancy/ Company Secretary as awarded by the respective Statutory Institutes of India will be considered as equivalent to Master's Degree for the purpose of enrolment for Ph.D.

### Application Form and Fees:

The eligible candidates may apply online through the university website [www.arkajainuniversity.ac.in](http://www.arkajainuniversity.ac.in). The online forms can be submitted along with the Online Payment or Demand Draft of Rs. 1000/- (for SAARC Nations/ \$50 (for candidates other than SAARC Nations).

### Admission Procedure:

Admission to the Ph.D Programme shall be based purely on merit in Entrance-Test. The eligible candidates will be informed to appear for an entrance test on the notified date and time as given below:

The syllabus for the subjects for entrance-test consists of:

- **Paper I** - Research Methodology and Aptitude (Logical Reasoning, Analytical Reasoning, Numerical Ability, Statistics, Research Aptitude)
- **Paper II** – English Proficiency (as per TOEFL)

**Exemption** – The candidates who have qualified UGC-NET (including JRF)/UGC- CSIR NET (including JRF)/ SLET/ GATE/ M.Phil. / GPAT are exempted from the written test.

Based on the performance in entrance test, all the selected candidates will be notified to get enrolled in the Ph.D Programme within the specified date & time by paying the requisite fees, as applicable. In case of vacancy available after the admission against above entrance exam, a separate notification will be issued for the next round of examination.
