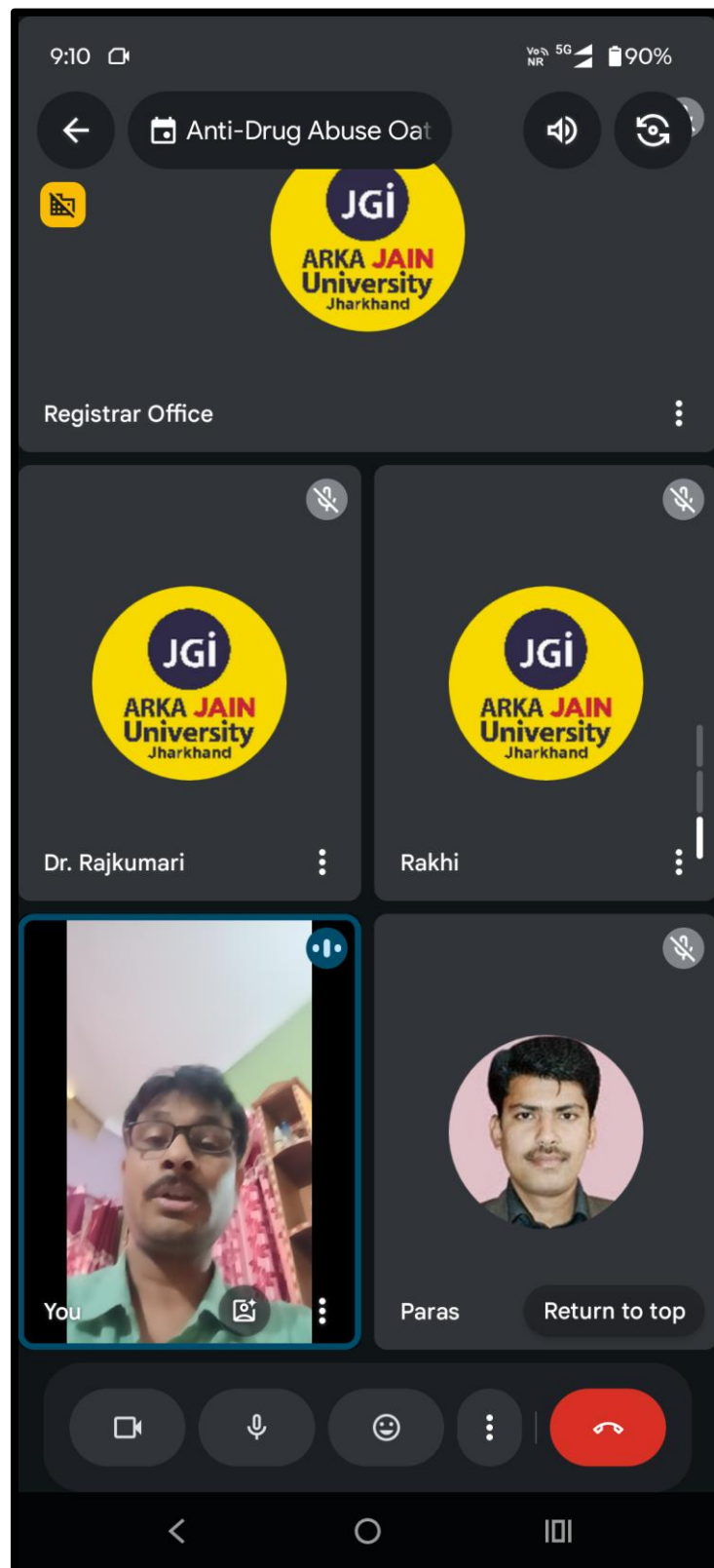


Fig.2- Nodal Officer, Dr. Manoj K Pathak administering Anti-Drug Abuse Oath

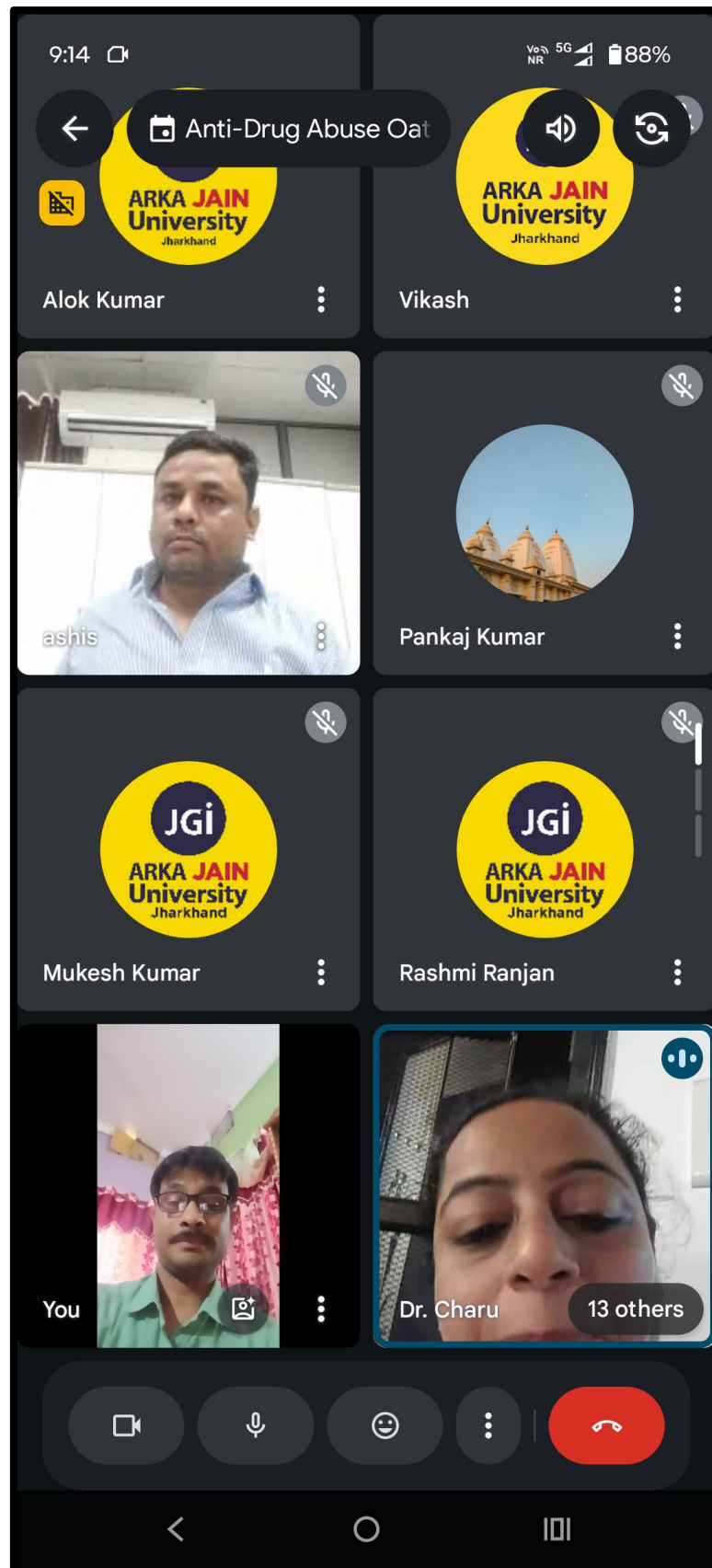


Fig. 3- Dr. Charu Wadhwa, Asst. Director, CCHRD sharing her views on Anti-Drug Abuse Awareness

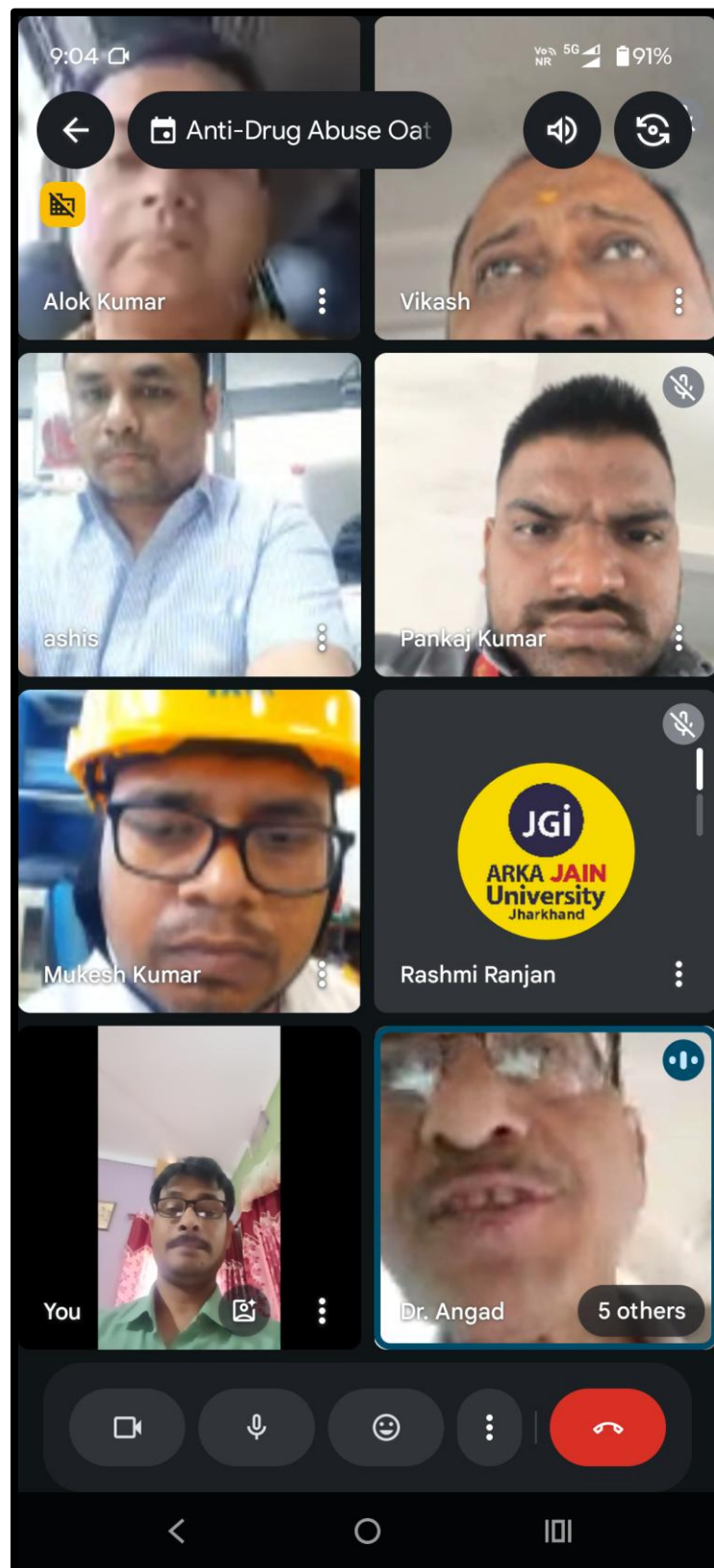


Fig. 4- Resource Person Prof. (Dr.) Angad Tiwary sharing his views on the menace of Drug Abuse

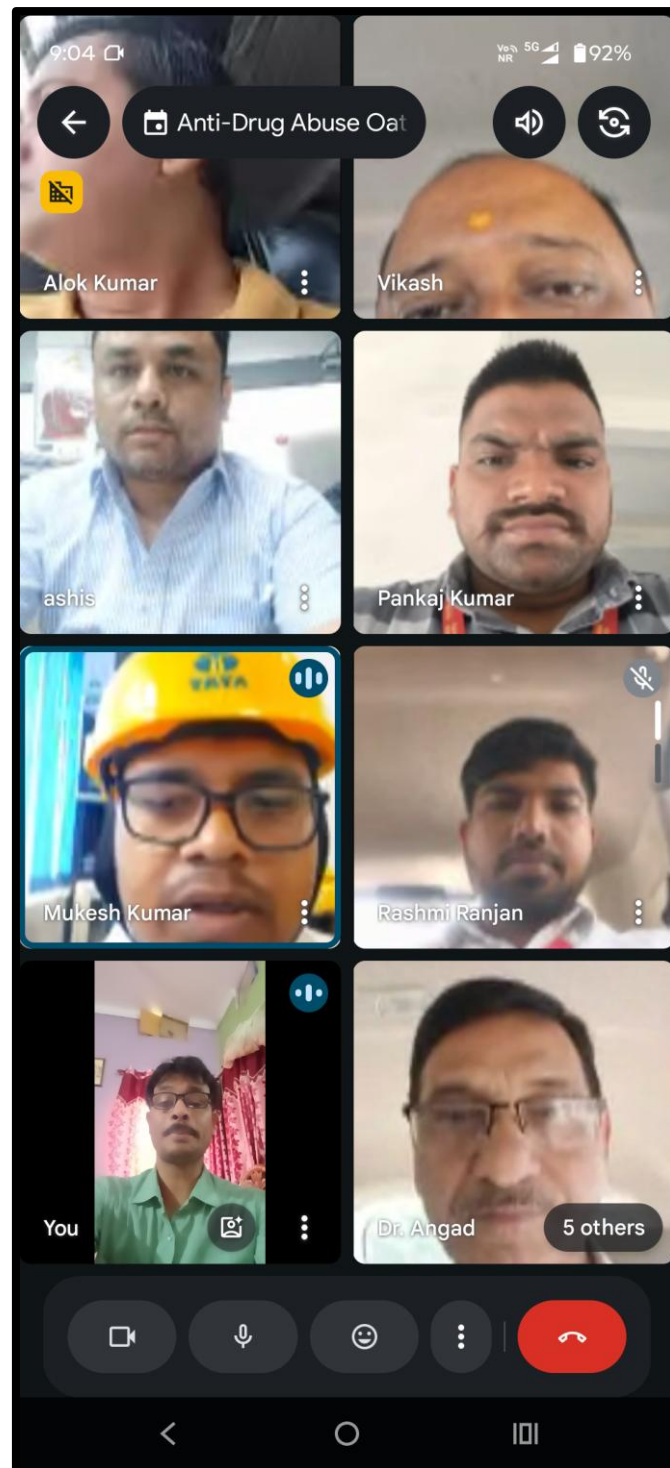


Fig. 5- Prof. Mukesh Kumar, Anti-Drug Abuse Cell Member sharing his views

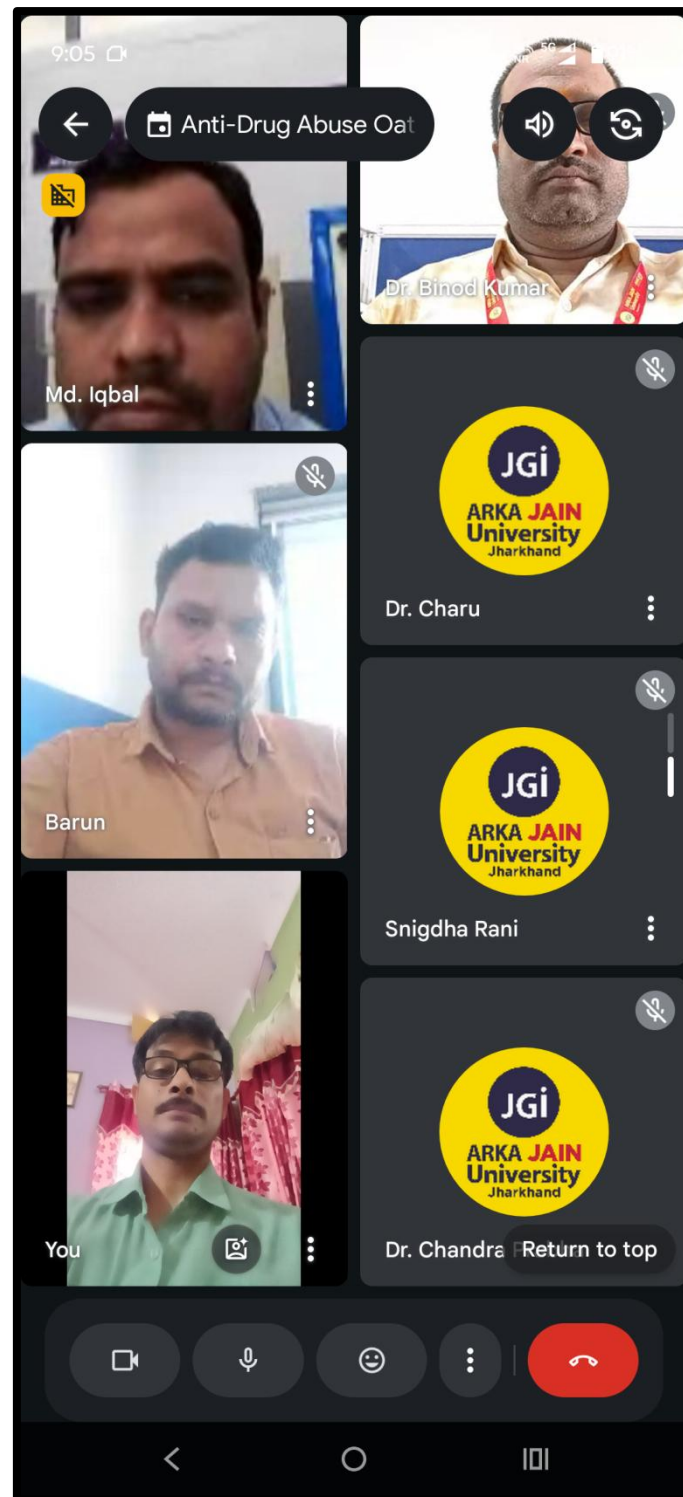


Fig. 6- Participants listening to the speakers during the session
