# **OBJECTIVE:**

This tour provided practical exposure to students, fostering a deeper understanding and appreciation for diverse fields of study and procedure of Apex court of the country. Additionally, educational tours stimulate curiosity, encourage critical thinking, and promote cultural awareness among students as students were taken to Supreme Court of India. Apart from this, students also got the chance to enjoy the scenic beauty of the mountains of Uttarakhand.

# **DETAILS:**

School of Law took 18 students for CARVAAN 2024. The trip started from 11th December and ended on 18th December. Students were taken by train in 3AC from Tata to Roorkee after which Dehdradun, Mussoorie and New Delhi was covered. Destinations covered in Dehradun was Forest Research Institute, Robbers' Cave and Tapkeshwar temple. Tour Spots in Mussoorie included Kempty Fall, Sunrise point and Mall road. Our main spot was New Delhi where every student was taken to witness proceedings of the Supreme Court of India. The primary objective of a court visit is to provide a comprehensive understanding of the judicial system and its functioning. This includes observing court proceedings, understanding court etiquette and procedures, and appreciating the legal process. Through the visit, students can gain insight into the roles of judges, lawyers, and other court officials, and observe the interaction between them and litigants. The visit also aims to inspire and motivate students to pursue a career in law, while promoting civic awareness and responsibility among citizens.


