OBJECTIVE:

- To raise awareness about the importance of water bodies and their preservation as part of the World Ocean Day observance.
- To instill a sense of environmental responsibility among NCC cadets and local citizens.
- To promote community participation in sustainable water conservation and cleanliness drives.

DETAILS:

On the occasion of World Ocean Day (9th June 2025), the NCC cadets of Arka Jain University organized a Pond Cleaning Drive at Mohanpur, Gamharia. This eco-friendly initiative aimed to educate the community about the significance of preserving aquatic ecosystems and to take concrete action by cleaning a local water body.

A total of 30 NCC cadets participated in the event, comprising 15 Senior Division (SD) and 07 Senior Wing (SW) cadets. The drive also witnessed enthusiastic participation from faculty members, local youth, and environmental volunteers.

Activities:

- The event commenced with a short briefing by the ANO and faculty coordinators highlighting the importance of World Ocean Day and safe water practices.
- Cadets, equipped with gloves, waste-collection tools, and eco-friendly gear, engaged in the manual cleaning of the pond by removing plastic waste, weeds, and non-biodegradable materials.
- Educational posters and banners emphasizing the value of clean water resources and the dangers of water pollution were displayed around the area.
- Awareness was raised among the nearby residents regarding the importance of preventing waste disposal into local ponds and water bodies.
- A slogan campaign and eco-awareness pledge were conducted to involve and motivate the local community.







Interactive Session:

- After the cleaning activity, an interactive discussion was held with the villagers and youth of Mohanpur.
- Cadets shared knowledge on sustainable practices to keep ponds and water bodies clean.
- Local environmental officers provided tips on rainwater harvesting, waste segregation, and community-level water conservation.
- Villagers were encouraged to take a pledge to maintain cleanliness and protect their local natural resources.

TAKEAWAY (OUTCOMES):

- The drive successfully cleaned a significant portion of the pond and highlighted the environmental responsibilities of the community.
- Cadets demonstrated teamwork, leadership, and a deep sense of ecological duty during the activity.
- The event fostered environmental awareness and a proactive attitude toward water conservation among both participants and residents.
- Arka Jain University reaffirmed its commitment to developing environmentally conscious citizens and supporting the global cause of ocean and water body protection.
